NATIONAL INSURANCE ACTS

Quarterly, Half-Yearly or Yearly Stamping of Contribution Cards

The arrangements set out below have the object of reducing the work of employers by permitting the cards of their employees to be stamped at quarterly, half-yearly or yearly intervals instead of weekly. The arrangements which may be applied only to employers of at least 50 regular employees in Great Britain require the payment by the employer of contributions in advance at weekly, monthly, quarterly, half-yearly or yearly intervals at the option of the employer.

I. The Minister of National Insurance is prepared to consider applications from employers for permission to stamp the cards of their employees at the end of each quarter of the four National Insurance contribution years (see Note 1 overleaf), instead of week by week, or, alternatively, permission may be given for stamping at the end of each such year or of each half-year. Special high value stamps representing 2, 4, 8 and 13 contributions (at 9/1, 7/1, 5/4, 4/6, 4/3 and 3/6) will be supplied for this purpose. Application for permission to adopt these arrangements should be made to the Ministry of National Insurance, (F.D. 15), Newcastle-on-Tyne, on form No. CF.46, obtainable at any Local National Insurance Office.

II. An employer adopting these arrangements will, in so far as the employees covered are concerned, be required :—

- (a) To forward to the Minister at the beginning of each week, month, quarter, half-year or year, according to the employer's option, a sum sufficient to cover the contributions due for that week, month, quarter, half-year or year.
- (b) To show clearly in his books the employees to whom the arrangements apply and the contributions payable in respect of them for each week, or when applicable, the reason a contribution is not payable, and to keep their cards separately.
- (c) To forward, on a form to be supplied, on or before the last Monday in each quarter of the four National Insurance Contribution years, a requisition for the number of stamps of each type required for the quarter, half-year or year then ending, with a remittance to cover any balance still due.

A reprint of this leaflet in November 1948 was almost identical. Another, dated July 1950, printed by Charles Birchall & Sons, Ltd. no longer includes note 2 and does not mention the 80/2d stamps issued in 1949. The leaflet for October 1952 differs only in the values of the stamps listed and the address of the Ministry of National Insurance which was added.

High Value National Insurance Stamps.

Permission to adopt high value stamping was only given to suitable employers who undertook to apply the arrangements to at least 50 regular employees. An application to pay by this method involved the employer being interviewed by an inspector of the Department to ensure that they were of good standing. An application for a permit to pay by this method had to be approved and a recommendation made to the Finance Division by the inspector.

High Value stamps were affixed to a person's contribution card by the employer. They were affixed to the card on the appropriate week - thus if an 8 week stamp was purchased it was affixed to week 8 on the contribution card, the next one would be affixed to week 16 etc.

An employer adopting this arrangement was required to pay a deposit to the Department to cover the contributions which would become payable during the period.

If an application was approved arrangements were made by the Finance Department, through the Post Office Supplies Department, for the issue of the required number of stamps to the employer. High value stamps could not be purchased at the Post Office.

Over the years different payment methods evolved, thus the High Value Stamping method decreased in popularity. By late 1970 no further applications for the use of these stamps were being accepted, but the system did not cease until 5th April 1975 after which Contributions were collected along with PAYE Income Tax.

Stamps defaced with the words **Specimen** or **Cancelled** or perforated through at an angle were preserved by departments the Inland Revenue or H.M.S.O. Those up to around 1970 have found their way into the British Library and those after about that date are to be discovered in the National Archives. There is slight overlap.























There are essays and trials in the British Library, some of which are listed in Roger Booth's Catalogue.

The paper of the first issues is watermarked MNI (Ministry of National Insurance) see page 20, but I did not look at any others. The sheet layout of the first issues is shown on page 24, but I did not look for the later ones.

Issues for Northern Ireland are listed in a booklet about the National Insurance Stamps of Northern Ireland.

I am grateful for the considerable help which has been received from David Beech and Paul Skinner of the British Library, Staff at the National Archives, and Alan Greenshields and Barbara Lewis of H.M. Revenue and Customs.

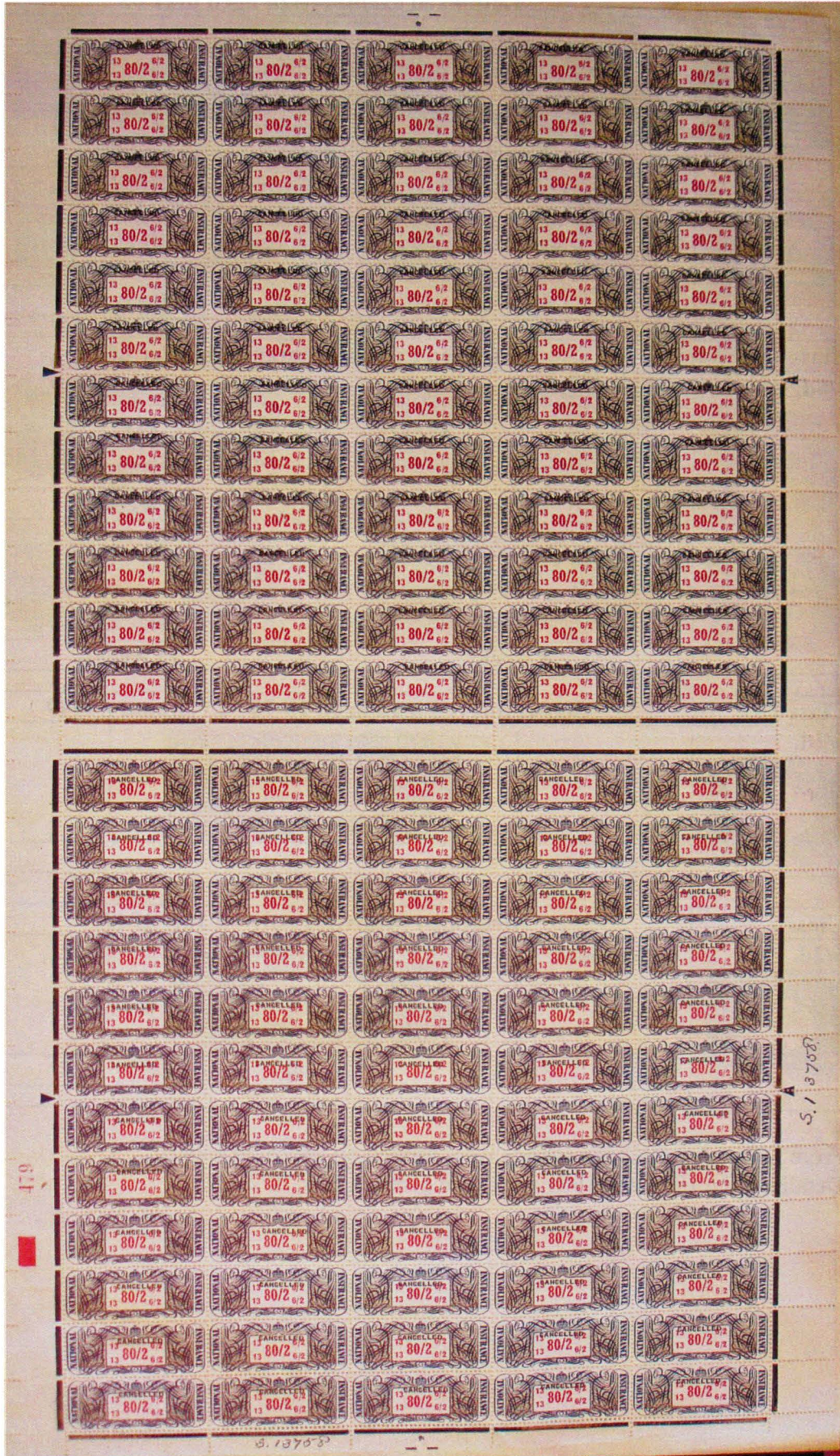

Stamping of Contribution Cards at Yearly, Half-Yearly or Quarterly Intervals

The High Value Stamping Scheme

The object of the High Value Stamping Scheme is to reduce the work of employers by permitting the cards of their employees to be stamped at yearly, half-yearly, or quarterly intervals, instead of weekly. Under the Scheme, which is available only to employers who will apply it to at least fifty regular employees, contributions must be paid in advance at weekly, monthly, quarterly, half-yearly or yearly intervals, according to the employer's wishes.

1. The Minister of Pensions and National Insurance is prepared to consider applications from employers for permission to stamp the cards of their employees at the end of each of the four contribution years (see Note overleaf) instead of week by week. Alternatively, permission may be sought for stamping at the end of each quarter or half-year.*

2. The arrangements include the supply of special high value stamps representing 2, 4, 8 and 13 contributions at the following main rates—12s. 9d., 10s. 5d., 7s. 5d., 6s. 5d., 6s. 1d. and 5s. 2d. High value stamps representing 13 contributions at 6s. 6d. are also available: these and the stamps representing contributions at the 5s. 2d. rate may be used for employees abroad—men and women respectively—for whom the employer's liability for payment of Class 1 contributions for 12 months has come to an end. Further details of insurance for employees abroad are given in leaflet N.I.38.

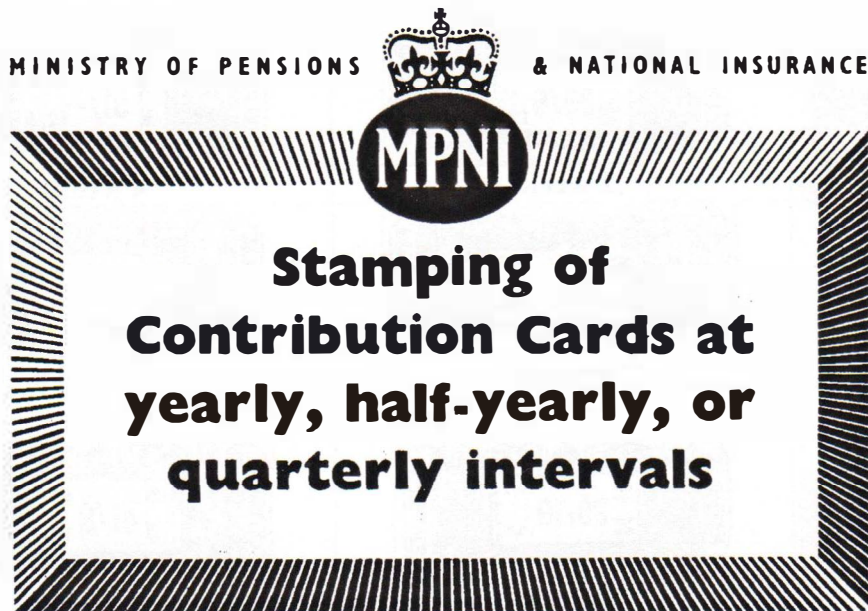
3. Application to adopt the High Value Stamping Scheme should be made to the Ministry of Pensions and National Insurance, F.D. 18, Newcastle-on-Tyne, on form C.F.46, obtainable through any local Pensions and National Insurance Office. If the application is granted, the employer will be required, in so far as the employees covered are concerned:—

(1) To forward to the Ministry at the beginning of each week, month, quarter, half-year or year, according to the employer's option, a sum sufficient to cover the contributions due for that week, month, quarter, half-year or year.

* Many employers will prefer to adopt yearly stamping in order to avoid the special procedure for the exchange of cards bearing high value stamps—see paragraph 3(5).

THE HIGH VALUE STAMPING SCHEME

What is this Scheme?

1 This is a scheme which has been introduced for the convenience of employers who can apply it to at least fifty regular employees. It aims to reduce their work by allowing them to stamp the cards of their employees at yearly, half-yearly or quarterly intervals instead of weekly. Contributions must be paid in advance at weekly, monthly, quarterly, half-yearly or yearly intervals, according to the employer's wishes.

The Minister of Pensions and National Insurance will consider applications from employers for permission to stamp the cards of their employees at the end of each of the four contribution years (see Section 3) instead of week by week. Alternatively, employers may seek permission to stamp at the end of each quarter or half-year.





















The arrangements include the supply of special high value stamps representing 2, 4, 8 and 13 contributions at the following main rates—12s. 9d., 10s. 5d., 7s. 5d., 6s. 5d., 6s. 1d. and 5s. 2d. High value stamps representing 13 contributions at 6s. 6d. are also available: these, and the stamps representing contributions at the 5s. 2d. rate, may be used for stamping the cards of men and women employees who are working abroad and for whom the employer's liability for the payment of Class 1 contributions for 12 months has come to an end. Further details of insurance for employees abroad are given in leaflet N.I. 38.

Similar leaflets apart from revised stamp values were issued in November 1958 and July 1961. In July 1961 This sentence is added to paragraph 1.











“ The scheme does not apply to graduated contributions which are collected through the P.A.V.E. system, along with the employees' income tax.”
