## **INTRODUCTION.....**

This is the second volume of the two L.P.H.G. are making available to members. (Part I appeared as Notebook 118 - 120 December 1995). As far as we are aware, the information has not been published previously.

Unlike Volume 189, Volume 190 was assembled by the postal clerks in a very scrappy fashion. For example, the Index contains entries which should be in the main text; the dates of the entries are rarely in sequence and do not allow the reader to follow the events occurring in any one year. The writing is often poor, bad grammar and spelling feature, all of which are retained.

Each entry has been given a reference number, known as the "entry number". These entry numbers do not, of course, appear in the original. The page number of the original is shown in the left hand margin immediately above the entry number of the first item from the original page. A number of pages have no entries or are missing; these are noted.

Where one Editor has absentmindedly given the same entry number to more than one entry, the other Editor dealt with the problem by adding an alpha suffix.

The date of the entry, in italics, is given first. The dating has been standardised to read DAY, MONTH YEAR.

Any stamp impressions, many of which are poorly struck and incomplete, are placed at the foot of the page with the entry number below the illustration. All stamps were struck in black unless an (R) follows the number, this indicating (R)ed ink was used.

Minor editorial changes have been made to the original text. At one period it appears the postal clerks were required to sign various notices as having been read. These signatures have been omitted, this being noted by (snr) = signatures not reproduced. The authorising officials signatures are given ( but see page 13). Paragraphs, if not reproduced, are indicated by a "/".

The original index is reprinted showing the page references of the original volume. As noted above, the index contains entries more correctly belonging to the main text. Your Editors have put these separately at the start of the main text.

A revised version of this muddled index has been prepared. This new version may be incomplete but should be sufficient to meet most requirements. In the revised index, the reference is to the entry number, not the page numbers.

Where the original text is missing (...) appears. When a reasonable guess as to the word or phrase can be made, this is shown in italics and between brackets to distinguish it from original text, as are Editorial notes. Initials and abbreviations are given as they appear and Appendix I offers suggested interpretations. The only correction to Volume 189 advised to the Editors, was KEB = Kings Edward Building(s).

For clarity, die letters are sometimes included in quotation marks, e.g. "A": these marks are NOT in the original.

The stamp identifying numbers or letters, from the base of the stamp, are listed, consecutively, with the entry number in Appendix II.
