### POST OFFICE SCHEME P2/1993

NOTE: The scheme which follows this note has been made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and amends the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Scheme 1989. The Scheme, which comes into operation on 26th April 1993, revises certain postal facilities and removes the Channel Islands and Datapost from the Scheme.

(This note is not part of the scheme)

### THE POST OFFICE INLAND PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 5) SCHEME 1993

Made.....13th April 1993

Coming into operation.....26th April 1993

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

#### *Commencement and citation*

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 26th April 1993 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1993.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Scheme 1989 (Post Office Scheme P1/1989) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1990 (Post Office Scheme P1/1990), the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme P1/1991), the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1992 (Post Office Scheme P1/1992) and the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1993 (Post Office Scheme P1/1993).

#### *ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS*

2.—(1) Under the heading PART II of the Scheme, the paragraph heading "6. Additional postage on certain parcels." shall be deleted.

(2) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted from the heading.

(3) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands and" shall be deleted from the paragraph 35 heading.

(4) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or to and from" shall be deleted from the paragraph 36 heading.

(5) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the paragraph heading "37. Postage not prepaid or insufficiently prepaid." shall be deleted.

(6) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the paragraph heading "38. Customs regulations, prepayment of duty and clearance of incoming packets." shall be deleted.

(7) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the paragraph heading "39. Incoming packets in bond." shall be deleted.

(8) Under the heading PART XI of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted from the paragraph 40 heading.

(9) The heading "PART XIII", "DATAPOST PACKETS" and the paragraph heading "42. Datapost service" shall all be deleted from the Scheme.

#### *SCHEDULES*

3. Under the heading SCHEDULES in the Scheme, the words "Schedule 6: Datapost Packets." shall be deleted.

#### *Interpretation*

4.—(1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, under the definition of "cash on delivery", the words "a Datapost packet or" shall be deleted.

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, the definition of "Datapost packet" shall be deleted.

(3) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, under the definition of "Despatch/Inpayment Document", the words "Despatch/" shall be replaced with "Cash on Delivery (inland)".

(4) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, the definition "incoming" shall be deleted.

(5) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, under the definition of "paper money", the words "(b) postal orders;" shall be replaced with "(b) uncrossed postal orders in which the name of the payee has not been inserted."

(6) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, under the definition of "paper money", the words "(e) bonds or . . . negotiable or not;" shall be replaced with "(e) bearer securities (including share warrants, scrips or subscription certificates, bonds or relative coupons;".

(7) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, under the definition of "postal packet" the words "or a Datapost packet" shall be deleted.

#### *Packets containing others for different persons*

5. Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 8 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

#### *Limits of size and weight*

6. In paragraph 10 of the Scheme, the words "In the case . . . Schedule 6 shall apply." shall be deleted.

#### *Payment of postage and fees*

7. Sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 11 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

#### *Unpaid or underpaid postage*

8. Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 12 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

#### *Postmarks*

9. Sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 13 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

*Return of undeliverable parcels*

10. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 15 shall be deleted and "(2) Where the name and address of the sender can be ascertained from the parcel, it shall be returned to the sender and charged with such an amount as the Post Office from time to time may determine." inserted in its place.
- (2) Sub-paragraphs 4 and 5 of paragraph 15 of the Scheme shall be deleted.
- (3) In sub-paragraph 8(b) of paragraph 15 of the Scheme, the words "or tendered for ... sub-paragraph (5)" shall be deleted.
- (4) In sub-paragraph 8(b) of paragraph 15 of the Scheme, the words "sender, addressee of substituted addressee" shall be replaced with "sender or addressee" inserted in its place.

*Redirection by the public*

11. (1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 20 of the Scheme, the words "or any substituted address" shall be deleted.
- (2) The semi colon in sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 20 of the Scheme, shall be replaced with a full stop.
- (3) In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 20 of the Scheme, the words "Provided that (without ... same delivery area." shall be deleted.

*Evasion of postage by redirection*

12. Sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

*Transmission of postal packets in bulk*

13. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 23 of the Scheme, the words "or Datapost" shall be deleted.

*Packets for which the Post Office accepts liability*

14. (1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme, the words "and Datapost packets" shall be deleted.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme, the words "or sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 6," shall be deleted.
- (3) In sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme, the words "or sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 42" shall be deleted.
- (4) Sub-paragraph (6) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

*Compensation for certain other postal packets*

15. (1) In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme, the words "(except a Datapost packet)" shall be deleted.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme, the words "In the case ... shall be £100." shall be deleted.

**APPLICATION OF SCHEME TO PACKETS TO AND FROM THE CHANNEL ISLANDS OR THE ISLE OF MAN**

16. (1) In the heading "APPLICATION OF SCHEME TO PACKETS TO AND FROM THE CHANNEL ISLANDS OR THE ISLE OF MAN" in the Scheme, the words "THE CHANNEL ISLANDS OR" shall be deleted.

*Application generally*

17. (1) In paragraph 32 of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted.
- (2) In paragraph 34 of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands, or" shall be deleted each time they appear.
- (3) In paragraph 34 of the Scheme, the words "for the place in which it was posted" shall be replaced with "of the Isle of Man".

*Compensation for certain postal packets to and from the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man*

18. (1) In the heading "Compensation for certain postal packets to and from the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man" in the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands and" shall be deleted.

- (2) In paragraph 36 of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted.
- (3) In paragraph 36 of the Scheme, the words "those Islands" shall be replaced with "the Isle of Man".
- (4) In paragraph 36 of the Scheme, the words "a Datapost packet," shall be deleted.
- (5) In paragraph 36 of the Scheme, the words "any of the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted.

*Postage not prepaid or insufficiently prepaid*

22. (1) The heading "Incoming packets in bond" in the Scheme shall be deleted.

*Postings in the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man*

23. (1) In the heading "Postings in the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man" in the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 40 of the Scheme, the words "the Channel Islands or" shall be deleted.

**PART XII TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS**

24. (1) After sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 41, insert "(3) On 26th April 1993 the Post Office ceased to offer generally the "Datapost" service as was previously provided for in Part XIII of the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Scheme 1989. In the event that any officer of the Post Office accepts a Datapost item for delivery after this date, then the Datapost item shall be deemed to be accepted on the same terms and conditions appertaining to Datapost items that were in force immediately prior to 26th April 1993".

**PART XIII DATAPOST SERVICE**

25. (1) The heading "PART XIII" in the Scheme shall be deleted.
- (2) The heading "DATAPOST SERVICE" in the Scheme shall be deleted.
- (3) Paragraph 42 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

*Rates of Postage and Limits of Size and Weight*

26. The following amendment is made to Schedule 1 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:
- In item 1 (a), columns 3 and 4, the words "For parcels to ... and girth combined." shall be deleted.

*Conditions on which authority is granted*

27. The following amendments are made to Schedule 2 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:
- (1) After item 3 (a) (ii), insert "(iii) In the case of any machine which is reset by the exchange of coded information on paper or a programmed electronic module by post, payment of fees as the user wishes shall be sent with the paper or module to the appropriate resetting centre. Resetting will be effected by the user on receipt of the returned paper or module containing the authorisation codes for resetting."
- (2) After item 3 (a) (iii), insert "(iv) In the case of any machine which is reset by the exchange of coded information over the public telephone network, fees shall be paid according to the specific system, either by direct debit or from a reducing customer balance to be replenished as required, and either to Royal Mail or to the manufacturer for subsequent payment to Royal Mail."

## POSTAL FACILITIES

28. The following amendments are made to Schedule 3 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

- (1) Item 3A (1) shall be deleted and "(1) The postal packets shall be made available for collection from the delivery office by the addressee or his agents during normal business hours. Alternatively, one delivery per week will be made free of charge."
- (2) In item 3A (1) (a), the words "of all classes . . . for the reception" shall be deleted.
- (3) Item 3A (1) (b) shall be deleted.
- (4) Item 3A (2) shall be deleted and "(2) Delivery fee, payable in addition to the fee referred to in (1) above, where the holder of the box requests parcels addressed to the box to be delivered to the specified address (other than the one delivery per week available free of charge). Each day that delivery is required" inserted in its place.
- (5) In item 3A (2), "£25 per annum" shall be inserted alongside the main item.
- (6) Items 3A (3), (4), (5) and (6) shall all be deleted.
- (7) In item 3B, the word "certain" shall read "most".
- (8) In item 3B, the words "by the postmaster" shall be deleted.
- (9) Items 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall all be deleted.
- (10) In item 9, the words "(This paragraph extends to any item transmitted by post)." shall be deleted.
- (11) Item 9A (c) shall be deleted.

## Conditions which must be complied with

29. The following amendments are made to Schedule 4 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

- (1) In item 5, the words "the parcel is, or is intended to be, registered, or that" shall be deleted.
- (2) In PART III (h), the full stop shall be replaced with a semi colon.
- (3) After PART III (h), "(i) jewellery; (j) antiques; (k) real fur; (l) prohibited goods." shall be inserted.

## Articles for loss of, or damage to, which, no compensation may be paid:

30. The following amendments are made to Schedule 5 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

- (1) In item (i), a semi colon shall be inserted after "jewellery".
- (2) After item (i), "(j) antiques; (k) real fur; (l) prohibited goods." shall be inserted.

## COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949
