SCHEME P2/1975

NOTE:—The Scheme which follows this note is made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971. The amending Scheme, which comes into operation on 17th March 1975, provides for postal charges generally to be revised, and for the conditions concerning postal packets in bond awaiting Customs clearance to be modified.

THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (No. 8) SCHEME 1975

Made - - - - - 21st February 1975

Coming into operation - - 17th March 1975

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 17th day of March 1975, and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1975.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P7/1971) (hereinafter called 'the Scheme') as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P2/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P6/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P8/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P2/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P6/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P1/1974), and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7A) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P2A/1974).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2.—(1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme after the words "United Kingdom" in the definition of "British postal area" there shall be added the words:

"including United Kingdom territorial waters."

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, the definition of "Commonwealth country" shall be deleted.

Letters and postcards other than air mail packets

3.—(1) Sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 5 of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1973, shall be deleted and the following inserted in its place:

'(1) Postage at the rates specified in Part 2 of Schedule 1 shall be charged and paid on letters and postcards posted by the persons mentioned in sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph when these are serving in the British postal area, and for transmission to any such person outside the British postal area.'

(2) For sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 5 of the Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

'(3) Postage at the rates specified in Part 3 of Schedule 1 shall be charged and paid on all other outgoing letters and postcards and on all other letters and postcards posted on board a ship registered in any part of the British postal area while the ship is on the high seas, for transmission to a person anywhere in the world.'

Other printed packets, small packets and insured boxes

4.—(1) For paragraph 7 of the Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

'7.—(1) Postage at the rates specified in Part 2 of Schedule 3 shall be charged and paid on all printed packets posted:

(a) in the British postal area for transmission to those persons mentioned in paragraphs 5 (2) (i) and (ii); or

(b) on board a ship of the Royal Navy (whether on the high seas or in any port or place outside the British postal area) for transmission to a person in the British postal area; or

(c) by a member of the forces referred to in paragraph 5 (2) (ii) serving as therein mentioned, for transmission through a British Forces Post Office at which British postage stamps are issued, to a person in the British postal area; or

(d) on board a ship registered in any part of the British postal area while the ship is on the high seas, for transmission to the persons mentioned in paragraphs 5(2) (i) and (ii), wherever they may be stationed.

- (1) The country name "United Arab Republic (Egypt)" shall be deleted.
- (2) The country name "Egypt (Arab Republic of)" shall be inserted in the appropriate alphabetical position.
- (3) The country name "Yemen" shall be amended to read "Yemen Arab Republic".

Air Mail Postage Rates—Zone B

14. In part 2 of Schedule 5 of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1972, the list of countries shall be amended as follows:

- (1) The country names "British Honduras", "Congo (Democratic Republic)", "Hawaii", "Sabah" and "Sarawak" shall be deleted.
- (2) The country names "Belize"; "Guinea Bissau (Formerly part of Portuguese W. Africa)", "Tristan da Cunha" and "Zaire (Republic of)" shall be inserted in the appropriate alphabetical positions.
- (3) The country name "Falkland Islands" shall be amended to "Falkland Islands and Dependencies"; and the country name "Malaysia" shall be amended to "Malaysia (including Sabah and Sarawak)".

Air Mail Postage Rates—Zone C

15. In part 3 of Schedule 5 of the Scheme the list of countries shall be amended as follows:—

- (1) The country names "Cook Islands" and "New Guinea Territory" shall be deleted.
- (2) The country name "Nauru Island" shall be inserted in the appropriate alphabetical position.
- (3) The country name "Marian Islands" shall be amended to "Mariana Islands"; and the country name "Papua" shall be amended to "Papua New Guinea".

Insured Letters

16. For Schedule 7 to the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7A) Scheme 1974 there shall be substituted the following:—

Commencement, citation and interpretation

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P8/1971) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P3/1972), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P5/1972), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P9/1972), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P3/1973), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P7/1973), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6A) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P3A/1974), the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P7/1974) and the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P8/1974).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Cash on delivery parcels

2.—(1) In paragraph 20 (2) (a) of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the fee of 55p shall be deleted and the fee of 75p inserted in its place.

(2) In paragraph 20 (3) (a) of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the fee of 12p shall be deleted and the fee of 15p inserted in its place.

Insured parcels

3. In paragraph 22 (1) (e) of the Scheme, the figure of £50 shall be deleted and that of £100 inserted in its place.
