

The total amount to be abstracted is as follows: From all or any one of the references above:

- 11,074,000 gallons between the 1st May and 30th September in any one year;
- 120,000 gallons maximum in any 1 period of 24 hours;
- 21,000 gallons maximum in any 1 hour period.

Further details: The applicant already has a licence to extract the quantities of water set out above from two boreholes into the gravel on the farm. The water is to be pumped from these boreholes into an adjoining ditch which is a tributary of the River Blackwater and the Rivenhall Brook.

THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (NO. 11) SCHEME 1976

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 26th day of April 1976, and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1976.

Bulk posting in mail bags

2.—(1) In paragraph 11(1)(a) of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1975, the amount "24p" shall be deleted and "32p" inserted in its place; the amount "£5.52" shall be deleted and "£7.36" inserted in its place; and the amount "£7.20" shall be deleted and "£9.60" inserted in its place.

(2) In paragraph 11(1)(b) of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1975, the amount "30p" shall be deleted and "50p" inserted in its place; the amount "£6.90" shall be deleted and "£11.50" inserted in its place; and the amount "£9.00" shall be deleted and "£15.00" inserted in its place.
