### POST OFFICE SCHEME L1/1991

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this Note has been made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982. The Scheme which comes into operation on 11th March 1991 revises postal charges generally and certain fees for ancillary services.

(This Note is not part of the Scheme).

### THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (NO. 11) SCHEME 1991

Made ... .. 12th February 1991.  
Coming into operation ... .. 11th March 1991.

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

#### *Commencement and Citation*

- (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 11th March 1991 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1991.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P2/1982) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P6/1982), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1983 (Post Office Scheme P4/1983), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 3/1984), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 4/1985), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 2/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 5/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 2/1987), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1988 (Post Office Scheme 3/1988), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1989 (Post Office Scheme L2/1989) and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1990 (Post Office Scheme L1/1990).

#### *Revocation*

2. The Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1990 (Post Office Scheme L4/1990) is hereby revoked.

**Air Mail Packets**

- 3. (1) In sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 9 of the Scheme as subsequently amended the amount "29p" shall be deleted and "32p" inserted in its place.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 9 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "15p" shall be deleted and "17p" inserted in its place.

**Bulk Posting in Mail Bags**

- 4. Paragraph 10 of the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1989 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:

"10 (1) There shall be charged and paid on mail bags containing printed matter for transmission as provided by paragraph 30, postage at such rate as the Post Office may from time to time determine.

(2) Where postage is charged and paid under this paragraph on any mail bag postage shall not be charged on any individual postal packet contained therein."

**Accelerated Treatment and Express Delivery**

- 5. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 29 of the Scheme as subsequently amended the amount "1.75" shall be deleted and "£1.85" inserted in its place.

**Registration**

- 6. In sub-paragraph (2)(c) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "1.55" shall be deleted and "£1.75" inserted in its place.

**Compensation for Registered Packets**

- 7. In sub-paragraph (2)(a) of paragraph 33 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£750" shall be deleted and "£950" inserted in its place.

**Advice of Delivery, Enquiries and Claims for Compensation**
