NOTE. The Scheme which follows this note is made under section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000 and amends the Successor Postal Services Company Inland Parcel Post Scheme 2001. The Scheme, which comes into force on 4 July 2002, revises certain postal charges.

CONSIGNIA PLC INLAND PARCEL POST (AMENDMENT NO 4) SCHEME 2002

Made 28 June 2002
Coming into operation 4 July 2002

Consignia plc^(a) by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and citation

1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 4 July 2002 and may be cited as the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 4) Scheme 2002.

2. This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Inland Parcel Post Scheme 2001^(b) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 1) Scheme 2001^(c), the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Posts (Amendment No 2) Scheme 2001^(d) and the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 3) Scheme 2002^(e).

3. A reference in this Scheme to the Successor Postal Services Company shall be read as a reference to Consignia plc.

Rates of Postage

There shall be substituted the following for Schedule 1 to the Scheme:

Consignia plc**CONSIGNIA PLC SCHEME OL6/2002***[This note is not part of the Scheme]*

NOTE. The Scheme which follows this note has been made under section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000 and amends the Successor Postal Services Company Overseas Letter Post Scheme 2001. The Scheme, which comes into operation on 4th July 2002 revises certain postage rates and fees and amends the definition of printed material that may be enclosed in printed packets weighing more than two kilogrammes.

CONSIGNIA PLC OVERSEAS LETTER POST (AMENDMENT NO 4) SCHEME 2002

Made 14 June 2002
Coming into operation 4 July 2002

Consignia plc^(a) by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1. (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 4 July 2002 and may be cited as the Consignia plc Company Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No 4) Scheme 2002.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Overseas Letter Post Scheme 2001^(b) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No 1) Scheme 2001^(c), the Consignia plc Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No 2) Scheme 2001^(d) and the Consignia plc Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No 3) Scheme 2001^(e).

2. A reference in the Scheme to the Successor Postal Services Company shall be read as a reference to Consignia plc.

Limits of weight and size

3. Sub-paragraph (4)(a) of paragraph 14 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following substituted:

"(a) pamphlets or leaflets means short printed publications or works of a literary character in book form sewn, bound or stapled within covers; and"

4. Parts 1 and 3 of Schedule 1 to the Scheme shall be deleted and the following substituted:
