Royal Mail Group Ltd ^(a) by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 89 of the POSTAL SERVICES ACT 2000 ^(b) and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st February 2010 and may be cited as the Royal Mail Group Limited Inland Parcel Post Scheme (Amendment No.15) 2010.

23. A.1 In section 23.A.1, in the second sentence, delete the text 'set out in section 23.A.2' to the end of the sentence and insert: 'set out in section 23.A.2 and one requested by the sender set out in sections 23.A.3 and 23.A.4'.

23. A.2 Sections 23.A.3, 23.A.4 and 23.A.5 shall be deleted and substituted by the following new sections 23.A.3 and 23.A.4.

23. A.3 Businesses wishing to use the Local Collect service must purchase and use LC004 labels to designate that the parcel which is subject to Local Collect may be sent directly to a Post Office ® branch for collection by the addressee.

23. A.4 The fees payable for LC004 labels are set out in or referred to in Schedule 3 to this Scheme.

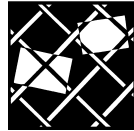
