## THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (No. 7) SCHEME 1974 <br> Made <br> 23rd May 1974 <br> Coming into operation 24th June 1974

The Post Office by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Pcst Office Act 1969, and of all other powrs enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

## Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.-(1) This Scheme shall come into oparation on the 24th day of June 1974 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1974.
(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Levter Post Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P7/1971) hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Ofice Overseas Lecter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 Post Office Schem: P2/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amindment (No. 2) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P6/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment No. 3) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P8/1972) the Post 0ffice Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Offica Scheme P2/1973), The Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Soheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P6/1973), and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendmant (No. 6) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P1/1974).
(3) The Interpretation Aot 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

## Bulk posing in mail bags

2.-(1) In paragraph $11(1)(a)$ of the Scheme the fee of 12 p shall be deleted and 16p inserted in its place and the words "with a minimum charge of $£ 3.68$ and a maximum oharge of $£ 4.80$ for any bag" shall be inserred immediately after the word "contents".
(2) In paragraph $11(1)(b)$ of the Scheme the fee of 20 p shall be deleted and 23 p inserted in its place and the words "with a minimum charge of $£ 5.29$ and a maximum charge of $£ 6.90$ for any bag" shall be inserted immediately after word "contents"

## Articles liable to duty

3.-(1) In paragraph $16(3)(a)$ of the Scheme the fee of 20 p shall be deleted and 27 p insented in its place.
(2) In paragraph $\left.16^{\prime} 3\right)(b)$ of the Scheme the fee of 40 p shall be deleted and 45 p inserted in its place.

## Express delivery

4. In paragraph 29 of the Scheme the fee of 20 p shall be deleted and 40 p insented in its place.

5. In paragraph $32(2)(c)$ of the Scheme the fee of 20 p shall be deleted and 25 p linserted in its place.
