NOTE. The Scheme which follows this note is made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971. The amending Scheme, which comes into operation on 28th April 1975, provides for the revision of the charge for a Forces Air Letter.

THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (No. 9) SCHEME 1975

Made - - - - 26th March 1975
Coming into operation 28th April 1975

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 28th day of April 1975, and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1975.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P7/1971) (hereinafter called 'the Scheme') as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P2/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P6/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P8/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P2/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P6/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P1/1974), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7A) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P2A/1974) and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P2/1975).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

"(c) on every Forces air letter, postage of 5p;"

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Royal County of Berkshire (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.) Order 1975 (Oxford Road, Purley)

Notice is hereby given that the County Council propose to make an Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be that:

- The speed limit of 40 m.p.h. in force on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice by virtue of the Royal County of Berkshire (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 17) Order 1967 will be revoked.
- The length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice will become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.

That length of the Reading—Pangbourne Road (A.329) at Purley which extends from a point 300 yards west of its junction with Westbury Lane to its junction with New Hill.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the Reading—Oxford Road (A329) at Purley which extends from a point 300 yards (274 metres) west of its junction with Westbury Lane to the Reading District Council boundary, a distance of 2,350 yards (2150 metres) or thereabouts. (483)

Westwards for a distance of 34 metres from the junction with Holmlea Road.

Ditton Road

Western side, for a distance of 30 metres from the junction with Horton Road.

Eastern side, for a distance of 30 metres from the junction with Horton Road.
