The British Commonwealth and Foreign Post Amendment (No. 2) Regulations, 1961

I, The Right Honourable John Reginald Bevins, M.P., Her Majesty's Postmaster General, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by sections 8, 15 and 81 of the Post Office Act, 1953, (as amended or substituted by section 28 of and the Schedule to the Post Office Act, 1961), and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do hereby make the following Regulations, that is to say:—

Interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations shall be read as one with the British Commonwealth and Foreign Post Warrant, 1959 (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") and the British Commonwealth and Foreign Post Amendment (No. 1) Warrant, 1961.
 - (2) The Interpretation Act, 1889 applies for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Despatch of certain printed packets

2. For regulation twenty-three of the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following regulation:—

"Where postage of one and one-halfpence, twopence or two and one-halfpence only has been paid on any printed packet and the packet is posted after such hour as the Postmaster General may from time to time fix, the packet may be withheld from despatch until any subsequent despatch."

Citation and commencement

3. These regulations may be cited as "The British Commonwealth and Foreign Post Amendment (No. 2) Regulations, 1961" and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1961.
