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Krag Machines in the London Suburban Offices Introduction

The aim of this study is to fill the gap in our knowledge concerning the use of Krag machines at the London Suburban Offices.

For some strange reason the subject of Krag machines used in the London Suburban Offices has been neglected until now, whereas Krags used in all other parts of the country have been described in the literature in some detail (see the literature list, page 11). Nowhere is there a simple list of the Suburban Offices which had used Krag machines, let alone a detailed listing. Of course there have been several books and articles written about British Krag machines and a brief summary may help to clarify the position described above.

Stitt Dibden & Lowder (# 1) cover the history and development of the Krag machines on a national basis and devote very little attention to the London Suburban Office group. Details of Suburban Offices are included in two chapters, one covering Krag offices in 1946 and the other the use of "The Great War Slogans" (1917-18). The first of these chapters lists only 4 Suburban Offices as Krag users in ca.1946 and the second aspect is more comprehensively covered in a booklet written by R.A. Keneally (# 2).

In another book (# 3) Stitt Dibden includes details about the historical background to many machine cancellations and lists the 22 Suburban Offices using Krag machines in 1912.

James Mackay has described the background to the English provincial Krag machines and includes a detailed list of known impressions and dates of use (# 4). As the title indicates the London area Krags are not covered by this work. Similarly, Mackay has also written a detailed book on Scottish machine cancellations including Krags (# 5) and Reynolds has produced an equivalent booklet covering the Welsh offices (# 6)

A description of the use of the coding system used in triangle and missort dies, including those used in Krag machines, is to be found in another work by James Mackay (# 7).

The British Postmark Society issued a booklet in 1963 which describes and lists the machines currently in use at that time (#8). This reference date is too late for the information to be of use in this study as almost all of the Krags had been withdrawn from London Suburban Offices by the 1960's.

The current British Postmark Society book on the subject of machine cancellations dates from 1983 (# 9) but, although it covers many variations in the format of dies and cancelling bars, it does not contain a list of offices or the dies used.

The last book to be mentioned is the 7th edition of "Whitney" (# 10) used as a quick guide by many collectors of British postmarks,. This book, apart from listing the earlier machines by type, has attempted to list and price the machine cancellations for all British offices from 1933 to 1996. Unfortunately the whole group of London Suburban Office machine cancellations has been omitted, perhaps in error or perhaps because no one has ever compiled a list of the Krag dies used at these offices.

Although the major office at Paddington W.2 is not strictly a suburban office it is included here as an integral part of the study of these machine cancellations.

Initially the Krag machines were introduced to busy offices to speed up the postmarking at peak periods which was mainly carried out by handstampers. Within a few years, however, most of the Krag machines were superseded by faster machines and the almost indestructible Krag machines were transferred to smaller, less busy offices. Even today, after more than 90 years of use, the last few Krag machines survive, mostly at remote offices. In the London Suburbs this situation was accelerated with many of the busier offices transferring from Krags to other types of machine during the early 1920's and almost all of the rest by the end of the 1930's.

The variations in die boxes, obliterating bars and the introduction of District codes will be discussed in sections 4 to 6.

Krag machines used for postmarking specific categories of mail are also covered later including PAID dies, slogans, triangles and missorts (pages 8 and 9).

While the main part of this study is concerned with "continuous impression" Krag machines, the relatively small group of "single impression" Krag machines used in Suburban offices (pages 9 and 10) are not forgotten.

From 1914 to 1921 a limited number of Alma machines were also installed at the Suburban Offices. The impressions from the Almas have a somewhat similar appearance to the Krags but, by comparing certain characteristics, it is easy to differentiate between the two types of machine. These differences are described in detail (pages 10 and 11) and it was thought useful to include the Alma machine impressions in the lists, in a separate grouping.

Krag machines were issued to all 106 Suburban Offices between December 1906 (Chelsea trial see page 3) and c.1935 (Abbey Wood).

The breakdown of the 106 Offices per District is as follows:

East	17
North	21
North West	10
South East	26
South West	19
West	13

The lists at the end of this study describe 281 different cancellation variants from these offices. This total has been much reduced by excluding all minor varieties of punctuation and size otherwise there would have been, perhaps, 350 to 400 different.

All 106 offices included their district codes in the later dies, except for Peckham and South Kensington. The Krags at these two offices were withdrawn and replaced by other types of machines at an early date.

There are two lists, based almost exclusively on the collections of the two authors, at the end of this study which are identical in detail and differ only in their presentation. Some London collectors prefer to collect each office in a strictly alphabetical order while others collect per district. Both groups are catered for.

Early Krag Trials

The Krag story in England began with an experimental machine installed at the London W.C. office in 1905. Details of these early trial machines are well covered by Stitt Dibden (# 1). The first Krag used at a Suburban Office was a trial machine with a circular die introduced at Chelsea on 5 December 1906 according to Stitt Dibden. The earliest use the authors have seen is dated 29 April 1907 and this machine remained in use until at least 1911 (fig 1).



During the trial period a Krag machine was also issued to Paddington. According to Stitt Dibden this was about May 1907 but the first example recorded here is dated 30 January 1908.

By this time the design of the cancellation head had changed, the die boxes had become rectangular and the obliterating bars, when used, were 6 straight lines between the die boxes.

General Krag issues

Starting in 1909 other Suburban Offices were issued with the new standardised "continuous impression" Krag machines with 6 straight bars and the die box with 3 lines of text. The first seen by the authors is for Kilburn S.O. N.W. dated 24 December 1909 (fig 2).


Stitt Dibden (# 1) prints a list of 21 Suburban Offices using Krag machines by 20 March 1912 and this total becomes 22, if one includes Woolwich, which he listed under the Provincial Offices.

From this time on more of the Suburban Offices were issued with Krag machines and by the 1920's most Suburban Offices were using or had used these machines. At the busiest offices the Krag machines were replaced from early in the 1920's by other, faster machines such as the Hey Dolphin and Universal. Gradually even the smallest offices were issued with Krag machines to replace hand stamping until eventually all of the 106 Suburban Offices are recorded as having used a Krag machine at some time. The latest "first use" of a Krag at a Suburban Office is for Abbey Wood, not seen prior to 1935.

The numbers of Krag machines used in the London Suburban Offices declined rapidly and, by the late 1930's, only a handful remained. Post war use (from 1946) has only been noted for very few offices (see page 8).

3 and 4 line boxes

The initial issue of Krag machines included dater dies containing three lines of text. The top line was for the Office designation, the second line to register the time in hours and minutes and the third line was used for the date. To enable the machines to be used for prepaid mail an additional line of text was necessary giving rise to the introduction of die boxes containing room for four lines of text. The second and third line could now be used with GREAT BRITAIN and PAID plugs as and when required. Obviously it was more efficient to issue machines with four line die boxes which could then be used for both paid and unpaid mail and later Krag machines were mostly fitted with four line office dies. Occasionally one sees a Krag impression showing only three lines of text in a four line die (fig 3).



These can be differentiated from a three line box impression by its asymmetry – the gap between the first and second lines of text is different to the gap between second and third lines.

A three line box impression always shows the second line of text halfway between the first and third lines fig 4). In the lists this difference in layout is expressed simply as "3" or "4".

Many major offices with more than one Krag machine added an identification code to the die box. This was not used for Suburban Office Krags, with the exception of Paddington where identifiers A and B were placed in the die box.

Straight lines, Wavy lines and No lines

Straight lines

The first Paddington Krag (fig 5) was fitted with 6 straight line obliterating bars (6S) for normal cancellation purposes (earliest recorded use 7 December 1908).

By 1911 seven of the busiest Suburban Offices were using Krag machines fitted with 6S bars.

These were:

Battersea, Chelsea, Fulham, Kilburn, Paddington, South Kensington and Woolwich.

Wavy lines

From early in 1912, the 6S bars were gradually replaced by 5 wavy line obliterating bars (5W) (fig 6). This changeover was completed for all seven offices by late 1914 with Woolwich being the last to convert. The last recorded date for 6S at Woolwich is 29 August 1914.

From 1915 until 1920 an eighth Suburban Office, Rotherhithe, used a Krag machine fitted with the 6S bars which had been discarded elsewhere. The latest Rotherhithe 6S recorded is for 6-August 1920.

The earliest use of wavy line obliterators seen are:

23 January 1912 Stoke Newington & Wimbledon
29 January 1912 Notting Hill
7 March 1912 Finsbury Park

No lines

Occasional use of Krag machines without any obliterating bars has been seen for Paddington in 1908 on prepaid mail but use without bars for back stamping incoming and missorted mail is also known.

District codes

The first Krags in the Suburban Offices were issued with dies showing office names in several different styles. Some used the district name only (fig 7) whereas others added the district letters (fig 6). Some added S.O. to the name or S.O plus the district letters (fig 2).

The lengthy names of some of the Suburban Offices had been a problem from the start of Krag machines and several were abbreviated to fit into the available room. With the introduction of district numbering in April 1917, new machine dies were produced which incorporated these numbers. Three offices, South Kensington S.W.7, Walthamstow E.17 and West Brompton S.W.10, used a trial format where the district numbers were inserted between the cancellation bars (fig 8). Incidentally this illustrates a strange minute T, which is probably a broken letter, in one of the two die boxes



The West Brompton office die was later modified by adding the district number to the office name while retaining the S.W.10 cancelling bars (fig 9).



Shortly after these district trials, a standard format was introduced with the district number appearing after the office name in the first line (fig 10).




The extra district codes added to the existing names proved too much for some offices and, for example, South Tottenham N.15 with 17 characters, not counting the spaces, all crammed into one line became almost unreadable. The solution was obvious – at many offices the district code was transferred to the 2nd line of the die box which was normally reserved for Paid plugs (fig 11).



Some Suburban Offices made use of short horizontal bars on either side of the district code but there are variations that are asymmetrical, with just one bar to the right or left (fig 12).

These format varieties are noted separately in the listings. Other office dies are known with district code letters in several different sizes but these are noted in the remarks column of the lists.

Post War Use (1946 onwards)

Stitt Dibden (# 1) lists only 4 Suburban Krag machines in operation in 1946 – Abbey Wood, Fulham, Paddington and Woolwich. Bennett, Parsons and Pearson (# 8) report just one Krag in use at a London Suburban Office, Paddington, in 1963. These findings have been confirmed and, in addition, a (Paid) use at Battersea until at least 1976.

Paid Dies

Occasionally some Krag machines were used to cancel prepaid mail where the inclusion of PAID and sometimes also GREAT BRITAIN plugs combined with the normal red ink impression make them readily identifiable. The first date for PAID dies is Paddington 30 January 1908, struck in red ink without obliterating bars.

The PAID dies are shown separately in the lists after the unpaid dies for each office. They are usually struck in red ink and this is noted under remarks. Generally the Paid dies appear in a 4 line format with the office name and district code in the top line, GREAT BRITAIN in full or abbreviated in the second line, PAID in the third line and the date in the fourth line (fig 13).

Later varieties used for bulk posting arrangements at Battersea and Paddington include DP in the office die. Other variations, such as the inclusion of 2ND plugs or R instead of the date, are shown in the listing. Some examples for Paddington have been recorded with OFFICIAL PAID instead of GREAT BRITAIN (fig. 14).



The number of offices recorded as having using PAID dies is very limited and the existence of more is possible.

Slogans

It has not been the intention to describe the use of slogan dies on these Suburban Krag machines in detail as this has already been attempted in the booklet written by Keneally (# 4). Their use is noted in the listing, without specifying the exact periods recorded. The nomenclature of the dies used in conjunction with slogans is more accurate in our list than those used in the special publication. A typical "Great War" slogan in use on a Suburban Krag is shown in fig 15.



Triangles

As with other machines, occasional use was made of triangular dies with the telegraphic office code, e.g. for West Brompton FER (fig 16). Noted in the lists are those few triangles encountered during this study but there should be many more as yet unrecorded. All triangles so far recorded have included the telegraphic code letters for that office, except for Willesden,. which used NW10 in the triangular die on its single impression Krag machine.



Missorts

Missort dies used in Krag m/cs are rarely seen and the only record for Suburban use is with office numbers 61, Willesden and 75, Paddington (fig 17). Although not strictly of Suburban origin, it is worth mentioning dies in the same style with numbers 79 and 89 used respectively at London SWDO and London WDO.

Single Impression Krags

From 1923 a few Krag machines were fitted with single impression dies. Willesden was one of five offices spread throughout England and Scotland which took part in the trials of a single impression Krag machine in 1927-28. These appeared with a single circle office die (fig 18).

A second, limited issue of single impression Krag machines took place in 1929 and again Willesden was involved. This time the Office dies are characterised by a double circle format (fig. 19). Two other Suburban Offices, Kilburn and Stratford, were also issued with this type of Krag.



During 1933 these Krag dies were standardised in appearance to become indistinguishable from the other Universal dies then current and are thus no longer identifiable as Krags.

Paid dies within a single or double squared box were also used with the single impression Krags but these are seldom seen. There is no report of an example on the single impression Krags at the three Suburban offices.

Alma Machines

Three of the suburban offices also used Alma machines for short periods between 1914 and 1921. The first Alma to be used in a Suburban Office was at New Cross where a trial machine was used for a short period in mid-1914 (fig 20). This was quickly replaced by a Krag later in that year. The other two Suburban Offices to use Almas were Kensington and Woolwich (fig 21) and these were in operation from 1914 to 1921.



The Alma machines appear to give a similar impression as the Krag machine but the general series machines can be easily identified by comparing the following characteristics:

- Distance between similar parts of impression: Alma m/c 76 77 mm. Krag m/c 78 79 mm.
- Alma m/cs have a slightly smaller size of lettering.
- Figure "1" in time slugs were with serif in the Alma m/c and sans serif in the Krag.
- The Master die box "+" symbol generally appears after the date on the same line in Alma and below the bottom date line on the Krag.

Explanation of lists

The columns are laid out as follows:

Column 1	The Office designation as appearing in the die box. A / indicates a new line of text. There are many variations in the presence or absence of full stops apart from those caused by poor or indistinct impressions: these minor varieties are not listed separately. The standard form of full stop use is listed but this is not always the case for some offices. The original list, kept for reference, contained a hundred or more of these minor variations and to include them would create more confusion than can be warranted.
Column 2	3 and 4 show the number of lines of text in the die box. O is a single circle die and OO is a double circle die
Column 3	The number of obliterating bars. S = Straight lines W = Wavy lines Where slogans or district codes were used instead of / or in addition to obliterating bars, this is noted in column 6 and / or 8.
Column 4	Earliest date of use recorded by the authors
Column 5	Latest date of use recorded by the authors
Column 6	Slogans B = Buy National War Bonds Now (Battersea and Paddington Krags plus Kensington and Woolwich Almas only) No examples of the Slogan 'Buy National War Bonds' are known on Suburban Krags. FTG = Feed The Guns With War Bonds
Column 7	Triangle dies seen by the authors. All are three letter telegraphic office codes except for the Willesden single impression machine that used N.W.10

Introduction

This is the 1st supplement to 'KRAG MACHINES IN THE LONDON SUBURBAN OFFICES' published in 2003 by the London Postal History Group (LPHG Handbook No. 19)

In the intervening 5 years the authors have received additional information and some minor corrections from several interested collectors. Most of the additional data is in the form of new early or late dates of use of the various machine dies and this has now been included in the revised listing that follows. The updated listing has been restricted to one in alphabetical order but this should offer no great difficulty to those collectors who prefer to arrange their collections in district order. Although the remainder of the layout of the listing is unchanged we have added a new first column containing a reference number to ease identification of particular dies.

No dramatic new discoveries have been reported since 2003 but the number of distinctly different impressions has been increased from 281 to 294. The qualification to merit a separate entry in the listing is still based on the standpoint that we cannot attempt to list all minor 'punctuation' varieties where, in the course of use, a full stop has been added or erased or has just worn away or has not printed. Of the 240 registered changes to the original listing, 13 are new dies, 194 are extensions to early or late dates and the remaining 33 are miscellaneous corrections and additions.

Detailed changes to the original publication:

Page 3 After the breakdown of District Offices list change 281 different cancellations to 297 different cancellations

Page 5 Straight Lines - change the earliest recorded use (Paddington) from 7 December 1908 to 5 November 1908

Page 5 Wavy Lines - change the latest 6S use at Woolwich from 29 August 1914 to 3 October 1914

Page 6 Top of page. The Rotherhithe 6S is now recorded in use until 7 June 1921 (was 6 August 1920)

Page 7 District codes. Perhaps the most unusual discovery to be reported in this supplement is an impression of a Poplar machine with one box showing E. and the other E.14. This is illustrated below.
