

**P. 635. AIR MAIL LEAFLET (July, 1926 Edition). CORRECTION NOTICE No. 2.**

**1. COLOMBIAN AIR MAIL SERVICE (South America).**—Official arrangements have been made whereby (unregistered) letters, printed papers, etc., may be posted under the usual general conditions for onward transmission by this Service. Particulars are given in tabular form below:—

(a) Correspondence intended for transmission by this Service **cannot**, for the present, **be registered**.

(b) The **special fee** payable (in addition to ordinary foreign postage at the rate applicable to the class of packet concerned) is as follows:—

Letters and Postcards—~~Is. per oz. or fraction thereof~~ 1s. per  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz. or fraction thereof.

Printed and Commercial Papers, Samples etc.—6d. per  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz. or fraction thereof.

Insufficiently prepaid correspondence will be excluded from the Air Mail.

(c) The dates and latest times of posting will in general be the same as for the ordinary Mails for Colombia (S.A.) despatched via New York. There is, however, no late fee posting by boat train at Waterloo or Euston Station in London.
