# Introduction

This document is a transcript of the archive file <u>POST 47/945</u> stored in The Postal Museum. It is a part of the "REPS deposit" – a large collection of materials relating to military posts transferred from the Royal Engineers Postal Section. It is described as:

"Operational manual for counter services in North West Europe, issued May 1967 by the Postal and Courier Communications Directorate, HQ British Army of the Rhine and containing updates up to July 1971"

It consists of typed/duplicated pages stored in a loose-leaf binder, presumably to allow for revised pages to be inserted when necessary. Although the date on the front cover is 1967, most of the pages in the extant binder appear to relate to the early decimal rates of 1971. It includes a distribution list showing it was one of over a hundred copies issued by the Directorate, and appears from internal evidence to have been one retained for their own use.

This is a transcription of the document, not a copy, but the text is all there, and I have made a best-effort attempt at reproducing the formatting as closely as I could (this explains the somewhat variable layout!). The page numbering is as in the original, which is not strictly sequential in places. Strikethrough text shows a crossing-out, and text in this font indicates a manuscript addition. In one case — on page 8 — an amendment has been stuck in, and this is shown as a text box with a different background colour. All pages were single sided, but for reading convenience I have omitted most of the "blanks", except where they mark a new section.

The document is presented as a seldom-seen example of an original operational manual showing what the practice was supposed to be at the time, but some pages may well have been replaced in actual use. For example, page 4, "Stocks which will be held at Forces Post Office counters" includes a list of postal stationery items, some of which have never been recorded; the list appears to have been prepared in advance of decimalisation, and should probably have been updated.

- This Compendium has been prepared to assist Counter Clerks and to provide them with a convenient reference from which they can answer questions from the public about the services available, rates of postage and special conditions that apply to various services. It is also a valuable book of reference for all ranks of the Forces Postal Service.
- It will be read in conjunction, where applicable, with
  - a. BRITISH POST OFFICE GUIDE,
  - b. RE PS STANDING ORDERS (N.W. EUROPE),
  - c. BAOR STANDING ORDERS SECTION XXXIII
- Counter Clarks will ensure that items of letter correspondence, letter packets and parcels - both Insured and Ordinary - for despatch by Air Mail or Surface route which they accept are correctly documented for Customs treatment and that the correct rate of postage is charged for the service which is to be given.

- b. Organisations listed at 2b are due to pay full postage and registration fees on all "official" correspondence tendered for despatch at Forces Post Offices. Exceptionally, however, the Army \*"SERVICES KINEMA Cinema Corporation and RAF Cinema Corporation \*"CORPORATION IS \* are\*permitted to despatch training films free of postage within the normal limits of weight and size.
- c. Allied personnel and their dependants serving with or attached to British fmns or units are permitted to use the Forces Post Service for the despatch and receipt of mail only; they will not be permitted to make use of remittance facilities.
- 4. Locally recruited civilians whether of British or any other nationality are NOT permitted to use any of the facilities provided by the Forces Postal Service.
- 5. Members of the German Civil Labour Organisation (CCLO) and the mixed Service Organisation (MSO) are not permitted under normal circumstances to any of the facilities provided by the Forces Postal Service. If, however, such units are required to serve outside Germany special authority to use the Forces Postal Service may be granted on application for a limited period only.

  - 2. Forces Air Letter forms, issued free on request against the Purchase of a postage stamp.
- f. 1. Letter card, impressed with a  $1\frac{1}{2}p$  postage stamp. Cost 2p each or 20p per packet of 10.
  - 2. Letter card, impressed with a 2p postage stamp, cost  $2\frac{1}{2}p$  each or 24p per pack of 10.

# LETTER POST REGULATIONS

# 1. LETTERS AND LETTER PACKETS

a. A letter or letter packet is defined as an item weighing up to 4lbs within the following dimensions:-

# MAXIMUM

3 feet in length, width and depth combined, but the greatest dimension must not exceed 2 feet. If in the form of a roll, the length and twice the diameter combined must not exceed 3 feet 5 inches, and the greatest dimension must not exceed 2 feet 11 inches.

# MINIMUM

One surface  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches in length,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches in width unless provided with a strong address label at least 4 inches in length and  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches in width. If in the form of a roll the minimum size is  $6\frac{1}{4}$  inches for the length and twice the diameter combined (at least 4 inches for the greatest dimension), unless provided with a strong address label at least 4 inches in length and  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches in width.

b. The word LETTER should be placed on the address side of letter packets which, by reason of their size or make-up, could be mistaken for other classes of packets.

## 2. POSTCARDS

Maximum size - 5% inches by 4% inches Minimum size - 5% inches by 3% inches

# 3. REGISTRATION

Letters, letter packets, postcards and printed papers may be registered, whether sent by air or surface. Registration fee, additional to postage is 20p. Maximum compensation payable is f5.50.

# 4. <u>CERTIFICATE OF POSTING</u>

A certificate of posting may be given for all letter items on Form P 326 B on payment of 1p.

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# PARCEL POST REGULATIONS

# 1. <u>LIMITS OF WEIGHT AND SIZE</u>

A parcel may weigh up to 22 lbs in weight to most destinations. The Post Office Guide should be consulted in all cases. The limits of size are:-

# MAXIMUM

3 Feet 6 inches in length and 6 feet 7 inches in length and girth combined.

## MINIMUM

One surface  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches in length,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches in width unless provided with a strong address label at least 4 inches in length and  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches in width. If in the form of a roll the minimum size is  $6\frac{1}{4}$  inches for the length and twice the diameter combined (at least 4 inches for the greatest dimension), unless provided with a strong address label at least 4 inches in length and  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches in width.

## 2. CUSTOMS CONTROL

All parcels to the United Kingdom or to BFPO addresses must bear a Customs Declaration AF W 5128. To all other destinations the Post Office Guide should be consulted for the type of Customs Declaration/Postal Despatch note to be used.

Prohibitions and restrictions are as detailed in the Post Office  $\mbox{\sc Guide.}$ 

# 3. PARCEL INSURANCE

Parcels (air and surface) addressed to UK and other Forces addresses only, may be insured up to a limit of £50.

An insured parcel may not be insured for more than the actual value of contents and packing. Fees are:-  $\,$

# 4. CERTIFICATE OF POSTING

A certificate of posting may be issued free of charge.

5. Parcels cannot be registered, but they may be insured.

- (b) The service is designed to provide communications in general faster than the normal postal service, but not necessarily so fast as UK Inland telegrams or normal overseas telegrams.
- (c) Within Great Britain, Northern Ireland and the Irish Republic normal telegraph transmission is provided both for telegrams addressed to BAOR, and for telegrams received from BAOR for delivery in those countries.
- (d) Within BAOR telegraph transmission is guaranteed only between the BAOR POSTAGRAM concentration offices at RHEINDAHLEN and HERFORD. On receipt at the POSTAGRAM centres the messages are due to be forwarded by post for collection and delivery by the Unit Post Orderly but wherever possible quiet telephone periods are utilised to phone messages to the delivery FPO for onward telephone transmission to the addressees unit. In this instance confirmation copies of the messages are forwarded by post.

 $\underline{PARCELS.}$  Surface Parcel post rates of postage from BAOR to Commonwealth and Foreign destinations are those shown in the Post Office Guide "Overseas Post" Section.

CUSTOMS DECLARATION FORMS. The type of Customs declaration form required on parcels and packets varies with the class of item tendered and the country of destination. Particulars may be obtained from the Post Office Guide "Overseas Post" Section. Customs Declaration forms referred to in the Post Office Guide are "Adhesive Forms" PB 69 B, Non-adhesive forms PP 70 B and Despatch Notes PP 48 B. All Customs Declaration forms must be completed by the sender.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>. Letters, Letter Packets, Postcards and Printed Papers may be Registered to most overseas destinations. The registration fee is 15/-p) and must be prepaid in addition to the postage. <u>NOTE</u>: Some registered envelopes already include an element of 24dp postagw (see page 4).

## LIMITS OF WEIGHT.

LETTERS. The limit of weight to all destinations is 4 lbs.

 $\underline{\text{PRINTED PAPERS.}}$  The limit of weight is normally 6½lbs. Exceptionally the limit of weight for a single printed volume is

Now that the 'Commercial Papers' service has discontinued the following items previously accepted as 'Commercial Papers' will be admitted into the range of 'Printed papers'.

- (a) letter post items exchanged between pupils of schools, provided that these items are sent through the principles of the schools concerned;
- (b) pupils' exercises in the original or with corrections but without any note which does not relate directly to the performance of the work;
- (c) manuscripts of works or for newspapers;
- (d) musical scores or sheets of music in manuscript.

All other items formerly admitted as 'commercial papers' are to be accepted as letters only.
