* FRANCE (Paris only)—Semi-official service. Air parcels may be posted for Paris and its suburbs, but not for any other place in France. Parcels may not be addressed to a Poste Restante. Imperial Airways, Limited, undertakes the clearance of the parcels through the French Customs and their subsequent delivery at a charge to the addressee of 8f. per parcel. This charge is exclusive of ordinary French Customs charges. The sender, and not the Post Office or the Air Company, is responsible for seeing that the parcel is addressed to a place which is within the area of delivery. If it is not, the parcel will ordinarily be returned to the sender, who will be liable for all charges incurred. Redirection to places beyond Paris is not undertaken.
