SECOND CLASS MAILS BY AIR

Printed Papers, Commercial Papers, Samples, Small Packets (to those countries which admit them) and Literature for the Blind, may be sent as second class mail by air to the whole of the British Commonwealth and most foreign countries outside Europe at the reduced rates of postage shown in column 5 on pages 3-5. Such items must conform to the general regulations for second class mail set out at pages 77 to 86 of the Post Office Guide, and should be clearly super-

scribed in the upper left hand corner of the cover for the particular service intended, namely, *Printed Papers, Commercial Papers, Sample, "Blind" Literature or Small Packet*, as the case may be. They must not contain anything in the nature of a current letter nor be sealed against inspection. The minimum charge of 5d. applicable to Small Packets sent by surface route (see page 77 of the Post Office Guide) applies also to Small Packets sent by air mail.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FOREWORD

This leaflet is issued monthly, normally during the third week of the month. A standing order for subsequent editions, to be supplied by post, may be placed with the local Head Postmaster. The air mail services are subject to alteration from time to time, and particulars of any important changes which occur between successive issues of the leaflet may be obtained on inquiry at a post office.

EUROPEAN ALL-UP SERVICE

All letters (including letter packets) and postcards for European countries (except Iceland and Poland) are sent by air as the normal means of transmission whenever this will result in earlier delivery (see page 2). The general regulations regarding surface mails are applicable. Air mail labels should NOT be used.

SURCHARGE AIR MAIL SERVICES

Letters and Postcards: The regulations applicable to ordinary surface mails published in the Post Office Guide apply also to surcharge air mails, except that there is no Insurance Service. Where restrictions as regards limit of weight and registration facilities are in force, particulars are shown against the countries concerned on pages 2-5.

Air Mail Label: A blue air mail label, obtainable free of charge at any post office, must be affixed to each air mail item at the top left hand corner on the address side; alternatively, the indication *By Air Mail* may be written boldly in the same position; but the absence of an air mail label may lead to delay.

Air Letters: Air Letters may be sent to all countries outside Europe to which there are surcharge air mail services (see pages 3-5). They must be written on the special Air Letter form obtainable at post offices, or on privately manufactured forms bearing an indication that

they have been approved by the Postmaster General. Enclosures are not permitted.

AIR PARCEL SERVICES TO EUROPE

Parcels may be sent by air to most destinations in Europe. Particulars of the services appear at page 6. In addition to the acceleration afforded by air conveyance, air parcels are usually given speedy Customs clearance abroad.

POSTING TIMES

The latest times of posting shown in this leaflet are those applicable to unregistered correspondence posted at the London Chief Office, King Edward St., E.C.1. The latest posting times elsewhere, which in general are earlier than the London Chief Office times, can be ascertained by inquiry at the local Head or Branch post office. At certain post offices in Scotland, the latest times of posting for some destinations may be later than at the London Chief Office because Scottish air mails for these destinations are despatched by air from Prestwick.

TIMES OF TRANSMISSION

A guide to the times of transmission of air mails from London to the principal cities of countries outside Europe is given in column 7 at pages 3-5. The times shown do not allow for intervals between posting and despatch from this country nor between arrival and delivery in the country of destination. No guarantee can be given that the times shown will invariably be achieved.

SERVICES TO H.M. FORCES

Items of second class mail may be sent to members of H.M. Forces outside Europe. Special air mail rates apply to other correspondence for all members of H.M. Forces overseas. Particulars may be obtained on inquiry at any post office.

ALL-UP SERVICE TO EUROPE

(Except Iceland and Poland—see below)

Letters (including letter packets) and postcards for the undermentioned countries prepaid, for foreign destinations at the ordinary international postage rates, viz.: *Letters*, 3d. for the first oz., 2d. for each additional oz.; *Postcards*, 2d. each, and for Gibraltar and Malta at British Common-

wealth rates, viz.: *Letters*, 2½d. for the first oz., 1d. for each additional oz.; *Postcards*, 2d. each, are despatched by air or surface transport, whichever offers the earlier delivery. The payment of air postage is unnecessary and air mail labels or other special markings must not be used.

SURCHARGE AIR MAIL SERVICES TO POLAND AND ICELAND

Correspondence for these countries is sent by air mail if prepaid at the rate of 4½d. for the first oz. and 3½d. for each additional oz. for *letters* and 2½d. each for *postcards*. There is no reduced rate for second class mail. A blue

air mail label must be affixed in the top left-hand corner of the cover or the words *By Air Mail* written in the same position. The general conditions for *surcharge* air mail services as set out on page 1 apply.

Insured parcels are not accepted. A blue air mail label must be affixed close to the address (or to each address if the parcel is addressed in more than one place), to the relative despatch note if one is used, and to the trade charge card for C.O.D. parcels.

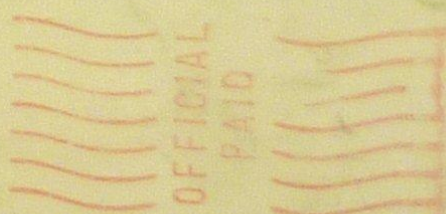
