

If made, the Order will not come into operation until 1st April 1995, or such a later date as may be determined by the Council.

Financial assistance will be available to enable fireplaces in eligible properties to be converted to comply with the Order.

#### SCHEDULE

Starting at the B5345 (St. Bees Road) at the point where it is intersected by the Wilson Pit Road, working in a clockwise direction, the boundary follows the centre line of the Wilson Pit Road in a north-westerly direction and then along the centre line of the High Road in a northerly direction to the point where a private road opposite Snaefell Terrace intersects with High Road. The boundary follows the centre line of this private road to the point where the Public Footpath to the Coastal Way, Barrowmouth, intersects with the private road. The boundary then follows the public footpath through the underpass and proceeds in a westerly direction to where it intersects with the old mineral railway footpath. The boundary then follows the public footpath in a southerly direction and then a westerly direction to the cliff side. At the cliff side the boundary then follows a westerly direction to a point where it intersects with the Mean High Water Mark. The boundary then follows the Mean High Water Mark in a northerly direction to the point where the Mean High Water Mark intersects with the West Pier (that lies between the Outer Harbour and South Beach). The Boundary then runs along the centre line of the West Pier in a south-easterly direction and then along the centre line of the West Strand to the point where Quay Street intersects with the West Strand. The boundary then follows the centre line of Quay Street, to where it intersects the B5345 at Swingpump Lane. The Boundary then follows the centre line of the B5345 in a southerly direction along Swingpump Lane, Newtown, Preston Street, Ginns, Meadow View, Low Road and the St. Bees Road to the starting point at the centre of the B5345. #### Commencement and Citation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st November 1993 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1993.
