Commencement and citation

- 1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st April 2004 and may be cited as the Royal Mail Group plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 7) Scheme 2003.
- 2. This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Inland Parcel Post Scheme 2001<sup>(b)</sup> (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 1) Scheme 2001<sup>(c)</sup>, the Consignia Plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 2) Scheme 2001<sup>(d)</sup>, the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 3) Scheme 2002<sup>(e)</sup>, the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 4) Scheme 2002<sup>(f),</sup> the Royal Mail Group plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 5) Scheme 2003<sup>(g)</sup>, the Royal Mail Group plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No. 6) Scheme 2002<sup>(h)</sup>
