ROYAL MAIL GROUP PLC INLAND LETTER POST (AMENDMENT NO 21) SCHEME 2006

Made 9 June 2006

Coming into operation 12 June 2006

Royal Mail Group plc^(a) by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 89 of the Postal Services Act 2000^(b) and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 12 June 2006 and may be cited as the Royal Mail Group plc Inland Letter Post Scheme (Amendment No 21) 2006.

2. 3. A reference in this Scheme to the Successor Postal Services Company shall be read as a reference to Royal Mail Group plc.

4. Paragraph 40. SPECIAL DELIVERY

Add sub-paragraph 40.14:

40.14. A Saturday guaranteed delivery service is available for an additional fee. This service is available only where a next day Special Delivery service exists. It is not available where Special Delivery items are scheduled to take more than one working day to reach their destination. The Saturday guaranteed delivery service is not available for any delivery address that is a Bank, a Building Society, a Travel Agent, a Jeweller or a Post Office.

5. Schedule 1. Postage Rates and Fees

Delete Paragraph 20 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
