Compulsory registration

5. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 39 of the Scheme, the figure "£2" shall read "£10".

Postings in the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or the Republic of Ireland

6. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 70 of the Scheme, the figure "250" shall read "100".

Letter and parcel rates

7. The following amendments are made to Schedule 1 of the Scheme as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1975:—

(1) Items (b) (i) and (b) (ii) of Column 2 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:—

SCHEME P4/1976

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this note is made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971. The amending Scheme, which comes into operation on 7th June 1976, in the main revises certain postal charges for letters and printed packets sent to Forces personnel.

THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (No. 12) SCHEME 1976

Made 14th May 1976

Coming into operation 7th June 1976

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 7th day of June, 1976, and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1976.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P7/1971) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P2/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P6/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P8/1972), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P2/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P6/1973), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P1/1974), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amend-

ment (No. 7A) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme P2A/1974), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P2/1975), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1975 made on 26th March 1975 (Post Office Scheme P7/1975), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1975 made on 28th August 1975 (Post Office Scheme P11/1975), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P17/1975), and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1976 (Post Office Scheme P2/1976).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibitions

2. In sub-paragraph (3)(b) of paragraph 12 of the Scheme, the figure "250" shall be deleted and "100" inserted in its place.

Surface mail postage rates

3. For Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Scheme, as subsequently amended, there shall be substituted the following:
