Application of the Post Office Inland Post Scheme

14. To Schedule 4 of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979, there shall be added:

Part VII (Compensation Fee Parcel Service) and Schedule 6

These paragraphs and provisions shall apply only to outgoing parcels posted under this Scheme for transmission through a British Forces Post Office outside the British Postal area.

References to "postage" shall be read as references to postage payable under this Scheme.

Part IX (Compensation for certain other postal packets) and Schedule 8

1. These paragraphs and provisions apply only to outgoing parcels posted under this Scheme for transmission through a British Forces Post Office outside the British postal area other than parcels on which a compensation fee has been paid as provided in this Scheme.

2. In paragraph 47 (b) the reference to "postage" shall be read as a reference to postage payable under this Scheme.

**POST OFFICE

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this note is made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1977. The amending Scheme, which comes into operation on 20th August 1979 revises certain surface and air mail rates of postage, certain fees and also amends the provisions for unpaid or underpaid postage on postal packets.

**THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST
AMENDMENT (No. 2) SCHEME 1979**

Made 1979
Coming into operation 20th August 1979

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other

powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 20th August 1979 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1979.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1977 (Post Office Scheme P5/1977) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979 (Post Office Scheme P2/1979).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1978 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament.

Air Mail Packets

2.—(1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 9 of the Scheme, the amounts "10½p", "11p" and "7p" shall be deleted and "12p", "12½p" and "8p" respectively inserted in their places.

Articles liable for duty

3.—(1) In sub-paragraph (3) (b) of paragraph 15 of the Scheme, the amount "40p" shall be deleted and "45p" inserted in its place.

(2) In sub-paragraph (3) (b) of paragraph 15 of the Scheme, the amount "55p" shall be deleted and "60p" inserted in its place.

Unpaid or underpaid postage

4. Sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 17 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following inserted in its place:

- "(1) An outgoing postal packet (including an air mail packet) upon which no part, or a part only of the postage thereon has been prepaid (not being an insured letter or other registered postal packet or a postal packet the postage on which is subject to such an arrangement as is mentioned in paragraph 16 (2) may at the discretion of the Post Office, unless it is dealt with and forwarded in the manner provided by sub-paragraph (2), be dealt with in either of the following ways:
- (a) it may be forwarded charged with the postal deficiency or,
 - (b) it may be returned to the sender in order that the postage deficiency be made good."

Express delivery

5. In paragraph 29 of the Scheme, the amount "60p" shall be deleted and "80p" inserted in its place.

Registration

6.—(1) For paragraph 32 (1) of the Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

"32 (1) Subject to the provisions of this Scheme, any outgoing postal packet, other than a printed packet or a small packet for transmission through a British Forces Post Office outside the British postal area, may be registered."

(2) In sub-paragraph (2) (c) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme, the amount "60p" shall be deleted and "65p" inserted in its place.

Compensation for registered packets

7. For sub-paragraph 33 (2) of the Scheme, as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979, there shall be substituted the following:

"33 (2) The total amount of compensation which the Post Office may pay under sub-paragraph (1) in respect of any one registered packet shall not exceed:

- (a) in the case of a registered packet for transmission through a British Forces Post Office the sum of £250 or such smaller sum as, in the opinion of the Post Office, represents:
 - (i) in a case where the Post Office is satisfied that any article enclosed in or forming part of the registered packet has been lost or rendered valueless in the post the market value thereof (excluding the value of any message or communication) at the time of posting; or
 - (ii) in any other case, the amount by which such value has been diminished by damage suffered in the post.

(b) In the case of any other registered packet, the sum of £10."

Insured letters

8. In sub-paragraph (1) (d) of paragraph 35 of the Scheme the amount "£600" shall be deleted and "£750" inserted in its place.

Compensation for insured letters

9. In sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) of paragraph 36 of the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979, the amount "£600" shall be deleted and "£750" inserted in its place.

Advice or delivery and enquiries

10. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 38 of the Scheme, the amount "12½p" shall be deleted and "15p" inserted in its place.

Surface mail postage rates

11. For Schedule 1 to the Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

TYNE AND WEAR COUNTY COUNCIL

(Robson Street/Wilfred Street, Newcastle upon Tyne)
(Prohibition of Entry) (Revocation) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that Tyne and Wear County Council propose to make an Order under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke the restriction which prohibits motor vehicles from entering Robson Street from Wilfred Street, Newcastle upon Tyne.
