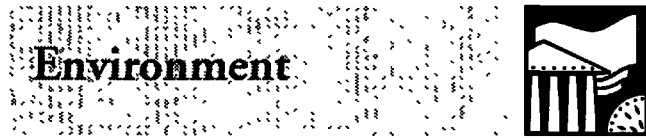

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 36(1)(a) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974, that an application has been made to the Scottish Environment Protection Agency by HM Oil Fuel Depot, Garelochhead, Helensburgh 84 0EH for consent to discharge up to 54 cubic metres per day of trade effluent from the sullage balance tanks (the contents of vessel bilges and wash down water), plus surface water from the bunker tank bunded area, sullage balance tank bunded area and Road Transport Wagon Area (total area 3500m²) to the Gareloch at National Grid Reference NS 2410 9006 from HM Oil Fuel Depot, MOD Navy, Garelochhead G84 0EH.

The effects of the proposed Order are as follows:-

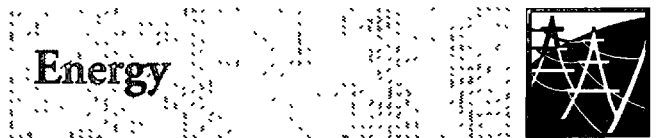
1. To authorise the following works in the Parish of North Uist (the points referred to being points marked on the plan deposited in connection with the Order).

3. To enable the Comhairle temporarily to close the area of the proposed works for the purpose of carrying out the works.

POST OFFICE SCHEME L1/1999

Note: The Scheme which follows this note is made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982. The Scheme, which comes into operation on 26th April 1999 revises certain postal charges and introduces a definition of Aircards, together with the charge for this facility.

Additionally, the Scheme introduces references to specific conditions and charges for Special Delivery packets where such items are posted through British Forces Post Offices or through an ordinary post office to British Forces Post Office numbered addresses abroad and also deletes the facility to post IPBS packets. (This note is not part of the Scheme)

**THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST
AMENDMENT (NO. 18) SCHEME 1999**

Made 19th April
1999

Coming into operation 26th April
1999

The Post Office by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and citation

1. (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 26th April 1999 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 18) Scheme 1999.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P1/1982) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P6/1982), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1983 (Post Office Scheme P4/1983), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 3/1985), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 4/1985), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 2/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 2/1987), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1988 (Post Office Scheme 3/1988), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1989 (Post Office Scheme L2/1989), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1990 (Post Office Scheme L1/1990), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme L1/1991), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme L2/1991), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 13) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme L3/1991), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 14) Scheme 1993 (Post Office Scheme L2/1993), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 15) Scheme 1993 (Post Office Scheme L8/1993), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 16) Scheme 1996 (Post Office Scheme L2/1996) and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 17) Scheme 1998 (Post Office Scheme L1/1998).

Interpretation

2.- (1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the following definition shall be inserted after "aerogramme":

"Aircard" means a prepaid outgoing Airmail packet consisting of a letter written on a pictorial card provided by the Post Office"

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, the definition "IPBS packet" shall be deleted.

(3) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the following definition shall be inserted after "small packet".

"Special Delivery packet" means, in the context of this Scheme, a packet posted as a Special Delivery packet for transmission through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address through an ordinary post office, the use of which indicates the desire of the sender that compensation may be paid in the event of loss or damage to any item of pecuniary value or of the loss of the packet, as specified in paragraph 33A".

Air Mail Packets

3. Paragraph 9 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

9. There shall be charged and paid:

- (a) on every aerogramme, postage of 37p;
- (b) on every Forces aerogramme, postage of 19p;
- (c) on every Aircard, postage of £1.30;
- (d) on other air mail packets, postage at the rate specified in Parts land 2 of Schedule 3

Accelerated treatment - Swiftair packets, Swiftair plus Registered packets, Swiftair plus Recorded packets and Swiftpacks

4. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 29 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, the amount of "£2.70" shall be deleted and "£2.85" inserted in its place.

Registration

5. In sub-paragraph (2)(c) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, the amount "£2.50" shall be deleted and "£2.60" inserted in its place.

Compensation for registered packets

6. Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 33 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

"(2) The total amount of compensation that the Post Office may pay under sub-paragraph (1) in respect of any one registered packet shall not exceed £28."

Compensation for Special Delivery packets for transmission through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address through an ordinary post office

7. The following paragraph shall be added to the Scheme, as subsequently amended, as a new paragraph 33A:

"33A. The Post Office may (subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph) pay such sum as it thinks just to any person who, in its opinion, establishes a reasonable claim thereto, whether as the sender or as the addressee in such cases where;

(1) the Post Office is confident that any article of pecuniary value enclosed in or forming part of a Special Delivery postal packet sent through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address through an ordinary post office is lost or damaged whilst in course of transmission by post or; (2) any Special Delivery postal packet through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address through an ordinary post office is lost whilst in the course of transmission by post,

(3) Special Delivery packets sent through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address through an ordinary post office will be posted under the relevant provisions of the Post Office Inland Scheme 1989 (as amended) relating to Special Delivery packets, apart from the following conditions which apply specifically to Special Delivery packets sent through a British Forces Post Office or sent to a British Forces Post Office numbered address;

(a) the facility is only available to British Forces Post Office numbered addresses;

(b) timed delivery, a facility relating to the Inland Special Delivery service, is not available;

(c) telephone confirmation of delivery, a facility relating to the Inland Special Delivery service, is not available;

(d) compensation for delay or consequential loss, a facility relating to the Inland Special Delivery service, is not available;

(e) advice of delivery, a facility relating to the Inland Special Delivery service, is not available;

(f) money or jewellery, as defined by the Post Office, must be sent in Special Delivery prepaid envelopes if compensation is to apply in the case of loss or damage.

(4) Postal packets referred to in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above are delivered by the Post Office to the Ministry of Defence, who arrange for their onward transmission.

(5) The total amount of compensation which the Post Office may pay under sub-paragraph (2) in respect of any one Special Delivery packet shall not exceed:

(a) the sum of £2500 or such smaller sum as, having regard to the amount of the fee (inclusive of postage) paid in respect of the packet according to the scale, set out in Schedule 6A; or

(i) in a case where the Post Office is confident that an article enclosed in or forming part of the Special Delivery Packet has been lost or rendered valueless in the post the market value thereof (excluding the value of any message or communication) at the time of posting; or

(ii) in any other case, the amount by which such value has been diminished by damage suffered in the post.

Compensation for certain other postal packets

8. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 37 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, the phrase "an IPBS packet" shall be deleted.

Postal packets posted on ships or by Forces abroad

9. In sub-paragraph (3)(d) of paragraph 42 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, the words "Registered Plus" shall be deleted and replaced with the words "Special Delivery".

10. Paragraph 50 of the Scheme, as subsequently amended, shall be deleted.
