THE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (NO. 7) WARRANT 1946

DATED DECEMBER 12, 1946.

We. the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury. in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1940, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster General (testified by his signing the same). and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners. order. direct and declare as follows:—

- 1. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Inland Post Warrant, 1936, and all Warrants amending the same.
- 2. The rates of postage payable in respect of inland parcels transmitted by post shall be increased by one penny at each step of the scale of weights and accordingly, on and after the date on which this Warrant comes into operation, the rates of postage payable on, and the limits of size and weight of, inland parcels shall be those specified in the Schedule to this Warrant and the entries in such Schedule shall have effect in substitution for the entries numbered 7 in the First Schedule to the Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Warrant 1940.
- 3. This Warrant may be cited as "The Inland Post Amendment (No. 7) Warrant, 1946".
- **4.** This Warrant shall come into operation on the 6th day of January, 1947.
