## Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post.

THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 7) WARRANT, 1903. DATED DECEMBER 31, 1903.

1903. No. 1174.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Ehert title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 7) Warrant, 1903."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1902\* (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the same.

Rates on parcels to Persia. 3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable under the Principal Warrant on outgoing parcels addressed to Persia, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in Part I. of the Schedule hereto.

Rates on parcels to Portuguese India. Maximum

weight and

dimensions.

- 4. On every outgoing parcel addressed to Portuguese India, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in Part II. of the Schedule hereto.
- 5. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General there shall not be forwarded, conveyed, or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight or dimensions respectively specified in the Schedule hereto.

Commencement of Warrant. 6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1904.
