We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Act, 1908,\* and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the recommendation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands

of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows : -

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 42) Warrant, 1911.'

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,\* and all Warrants amending the same.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

3. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 34) Repeal. Warrant, 1910, † is hereby repealed.

4. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on out-going Rates on parcels addressed to Abyssinia, there shall be charged and paid parcels to on such parcels the rates of postage specified in the Schedule Abyssinia. hereto.

5. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall Maximum not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 28th day of February, 1911.
