We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order. direct, and declare as follows: -

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title.

Parcel Post Amendment (No. 44) Warrant, 1911."

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Warrant to Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,* and all Warrants amend- be read with ing the same.

3. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 22)

Warrant, 1908,† is hereby repealed.

4. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on out-going Rates on parcels addressed to the United States of America and transparcels to mitted under the principal Warrant, there shall be charged the United and paid on such parcels the rates of postage specified in the America. Schedule hereto.
