We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the

hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 58) Warrant, 1913."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

- 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,* and all Warrants amending the same.
- 3. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. \$ Warrant, 1911, \dagger is hereby repealed.

Rates to British Solomon Islands Protectorate and New Hebrides. 4. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on outgoing parcels addressed to the British Solomon Islands Protectorate and the New Hebrides, and transmitted via New South Wales, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

Rates to Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorate. 5. On every outgoing parcel addressed to the Gilbert and Ellis Islands Protectorate, and transmitted viâ New South Wales, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified is the Schedule hereto.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

6. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there said not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under the Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which said exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedic hereto.
