1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 78) Warrant, 1916.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,(b) and all Warrants amending the same. (c)
