**THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 95)
WARRANT, 1919. DATED DECEMBER 8, 1919.**

1919. No. 2238.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1918,^(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 95) Warrant, 1919." **Short Title.**

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,^(b) and all Warrants amending the same. **Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.**

3. On every outgoing parcel addressed to any place specified in the First Schedule hereto and transmitted under this Warrant there shall be charged and paid the amended rates of postage mentioned against the name of such place in the same Schedule. **Rates on certain parcels.**

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the First Schedule hereto. **Maximum weight and dimensions.**

5. The Warrants specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby repealed respectively to the extent mentioned in the same Schedule. **Repeal.**

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 9th day of December, 1919. **Commencement of Warrant.**
