THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 96) WARRANT, 1920. DATED SEPTEMBER 10, 1920.

1920. No. 1757.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1918,(b)

and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 96) Warrant, 1920."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906, (a) and all Warrants amending the same.

Amended rates on parcels.

- 3.—(1) On every outgoing parcel addressed to the British Agencies at Constantinople and Smyrna, and transmitted by sea direct, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in Part I. of the Schedule hereto.
- (2) Parcels may be transmitted by post from the Agencies of the Postmaster-General established in the places specified in the first column to the place specified opposite thereto respectively in the second column of Part II. of the said Schedule, subject to the rates of postage mentioned against the names of such places respectively in the same part of the said Schedule.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Repeals.

5. The entry in Part I. of the Second Schedule to the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 52) Warrant, 1912,(b) relating to Parcels addressed to the British Agencies at Constantinople and Smyrna, and transmitted by sea direct, and the entries in Part II. of the said Second Schedule, relating to parcels posted in Constantinople and Smyrna and addressed to the United Kingdom by sea direct, are hereby repealed.

Commencement of Warrant. 6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 21st day of September, 1920.
