

**THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL POST
(AMENDMENT No. 7) WARRANT 1900**

DATED DECEMBER 13, 1900.

We, the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of Her Majesty's Postmaster General (testified by his signing the same), order, direct, and declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Post Warrant, 1898, and all Warrants amending the same.
2. The Foreign and Colonial Post Warrant, 1898, shall apply to letters transmitted to and from New Zealand as if that Colony were specified in the Second Schedule to the said Warrant.
3. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Post (Amendment No. 7) Warrant, 1900."
4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and one.
