POST OFFICE SCHEME T6/1975

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this Note has been made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and will come into operation on the 1st October 1975. It amends the Post Office Inland Telegram Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme T3/1971) as amended. The principal changes which it makes are to increase generally the charges for inland telegrams and telegrams to the Republic of Ireland, and for supplementary services.

THE POST OFFICE INLAND TELEGRAM AMENDMENT (No. 6) SCHEME 1975

Made - - - - - 29th August 1975
Coming into operation - - - - - 1st October 1975

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, Citation and Extent

1. The Scheme shall come into operation on the 1st October 1975 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1975.

Interpretation

2.—(1) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Telegram Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme T3/1971) (hereinafter called "the principal Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme T5/1972), the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 2A) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme T3A/1973), the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme T9/1973), the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme T3/1974) and the Post Office Inland Telegram Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme T2/1975).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Ordinary rate

3. In paragraph 5 of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "70p" shall be substituted for the amount "30p", and the amount "7p" shall be substituted for the amount "5p".

Overnight rate

4. In paragraph 6 of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "50p" shall be substituted for the amount "20p", and the amount "4p" shall be substituted for the amount "3p".

Money order telegrams

5.—(1) In paragraph 8 of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p".

(2) In paragraph 8(a) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "7p" shall be substituted for the amount "5p".

Telegrams for withdrawing National Savings Bank deposits

6. In paragraph 9 of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p".

Payment for reply

7. In paragraph 15 of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "70p" shall be substituted for the amount "50p", and the amount "£3.50" shall be substituted for the amount "£1.50".

Cancellation by sender

8. In paragraph 19(a) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "70p" shall be substituted for the amount "40p".

Re-direction and re-transmission

9.—(1) In the proviso to paragraph 21(3) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p" and the amount "7p" shall be substituted for the amount "5p".

(2) In paragraph 21(7) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p".

Name and address of sender

10. In paragraph 31(3) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p".

Application to the Republic of Ireland and the Channel Islands

11.—(1) In paragraph 39(a) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "80p" shall be substituted for the amount "35p", and the amount "7p" shall be substituted for the amount "5p".

(2) In paragraph 39(d) of the principal Scheme (as amended) the amount "£1.50" shall be substituted for the amount "85p" and the amount "£1.40" shall be substituted for the amount "80p".

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS**BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL****The Borough of Blackpool (East Park Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975**

Notice is hereby given that on 4th September 1975 the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 made the above named Order.

The Order which will come into operation on the 8th September will have the effect of introducing no waiting restrictions at any time to that part of the west side of East Park Drive from Stanley Park pedestrian entrance (adjacent to Golf Course) to the slip road leading from East Park Drive to North Park Drive.

A copy of the Order and of the relevant plan showing the restricted area may be examined at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Blackpool, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of those sections has not been complied with in relation to

the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL**The Borough of Blackpool (Church Street) (Experimental Pedestrian Area) Order 1975**

Notice is hereby given that on 4th September 1975 the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 9 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, made an Order affecting Church Street between its junction with Coronation Street and Corporation Street.

The Order which is experimental will come into operation on 8th September 1975 for a period not exceeding six months and has the following effect:

(1) Vehicles will be prohibited from that part of Church Street between Coronation Street and Corporation Street for the period 10.30 a.m. to 6.15 p.m. daily.
