## SCHEME P4/1974

Note: The Scheme which follows this note has been made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Note Inland Post Scheme 1972. The Scheme, which will come into operation on 24th June 1974, provides for new charges for letters, registered letters, parcels and various services.

(This note is not part of the Scheme).

THE POST OFFICE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 5) SCHEME 1974 31st May 1974 Made

Coming into Operation ... 24th June 1974

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

# Commencement, citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Schame shall come into operation on 24th June 1974 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1974.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P7/1972) (heremafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P1/1973), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P10/1973), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P11/1973) and the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P12/1973).
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament. Rates of postage and other charges and fees
- 2.—(1) The following amendments are made to the Scheme:
- a. In paragraph 6(2) for the amount " $7\frac{1}{2}p$ " there shall be substituted "10p".
- b. In paragraph 30(8) for the amount "£5" there shall be substituted "£10". In the case of a licence granted before the day on which this Scheme comes into operation, the first annual fee under paragraph 30(8) of the Scheme shall be due and payable on the relevant anniversary following on or next after that day, without prejudice to the right of the Post Office to recover from the lecensee the amount of any fee due or payable before that day under the provisions of the Scheme which remains unpaid.
- c. In paragraph 30(9) for the amount "£5" there shall be substituted "£10".
- d. In paragraphs 31(9), 31(10)(a) and 31(11) for the amount "£5" wherever it occurs there shall be substituted in each case "£10". For the purposes of the application of sub-paragraphs (9), (10) and (11) of paragraph 31 in relation to a Freepost Licence granted before the day on which this Scheme comes into operation and in force on that day:
  - (a) if when that licence was granted the licensee was the licensee in respect of a Business Reply Licence, every anniversary of the day when the Business Reply Licence was granted on which the Freepost Licence remains in force shall be a relevant anniversary;
  - (b) in every other case, every anniversary of the day when that licence was granted and on which it remains in force shall be a relevant anniversary;
  - and the first annual fee under those sub-paragraphs shall be due and payable on the relevant anniversary falling on or next after the day on which this Scheme comes into operation, without prejudice to the right of the Post Office to recover from the licensee the amount of any fee due and payable before that day under the provisions of the Scheme which remains unpaid.
- <sup>e.</sup> In paragraphs 32(3), 40(3), 44(2) and 44(3) for the amount "4p" wherever it occurs there shall be substituted in each case " 5p ".
- f. For sub-paragraphs (5) and (6) of paragraph 69 there shall be substituted the following:
  - "(5) With respect to the clearance through customs of a parcel or parcels stored in bond, the Post Office may charge a as follows: ---
    - (a) Where a parcel or parcels are stored for a period not exceeding 28 days, the fee shall be 80p for each parcel, except where two or more parcels are posted simultaneously by a sender to the same addressee, when the fee shall be:—
      - (i) Where there are not more than 5 parcels: 75p for each parcel
      - (11) Where there are more than 5 parcels but not more than 30 parcels: 75p for each of the first 5 parcels and then 50p for each additional parcel
      - (iii) Where there are more than 30 parcels:
      - for the first 30 parcels the fee for each as in (11) and then 27p for each additional parcel.
    - (b) Where a parcel or parcels are stored for a period of more than 28 days, the fee for each parcel shall be as in (a) with an additional sum for each parcel calculated at the rate of 5p for each working day (or residual part of such day) of storage after the first 28 days".
  - (6) The fees charged under sub-paragraph (5) of this paragraph with respect to each parcel (other than a parcel which is returned to its sender) shall be paid by the addressee if the parcel shall be delivered to him, or by the original addressee if the parcel shall be re-addressed in accordance with (c) or (d) of sub-paragraph (1)."

(Postal Order) Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P4/1973) and The Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P9/1973).
