## SCHEME P1/1976

Note: The Scheme which follows this note has been made under Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1975. This Scheme which will come into operation on 7th June 1976, provides for certain postage rates to be increased and makes other minor amendments.
(This note is not part of the Scheme)
The Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1976
Made
10th May 1976
Coming into operation 7th June 1976

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

## Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.-(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 7th June 1976 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1976.
(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P8/1975) (hereinafter called 'the Scheme') as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P13/1975) and the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P15/1975).
(3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament.

## Local parcels

2. In the definition of "local parcel" in sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme, after the words "means a parcel" there shall be added "other than one posted in any of the London postal districts,".

Return of Undeliverable Postal Packets (except parcels)
3. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 16 of the Scheme, the first three lines shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:
"(1) In the case of any postal packet (other than (i) a parcel, (ii) a letter accepted for transmission as a second class letter under paragraph 34, (iii) a current registered newspaper, or (iv) an election communication which has been received by the Post Office for transmission under Section 79(1) of the Representation of the People Act 1949) which for any reason cannot be delivered, the following provisions shall apply:"

## Registration of Newspapers

4. In sub-paragraph 6 (b) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme,
the words "is printed and" shall be inserted after the words "it is printed on paper and".

## Compulsory registration

5. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 39 of the Scheme, the figure " $£ 2$ " shall read " $£ 10$ ".

## Postings in the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or the Republic of Ireland <br> 6. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 70 of the Scheme, the figure " 250 " shall read " 100 ".

## Letter and parcel rates

7. The following amendments are made to Schedule 1 of the Scheme as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1975:-
