POST OFFICE SCHEME P1/1980

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this note has been made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1979. The Scheme, which will come into operation on 4th February 1980, provides for postage rates generally to be increased, and deletes references to various express delivery services which are no longer provided.

THE POST OFFICE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 2) SCHEME 1980

Made - - - - - - 8th January 1980 Coming into operation - - - - 4th February 1980

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 4th February 1980 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1980.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1979 (Post Office Scheme P1/1979) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979 (Post Office Scheme P5/1979).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1978 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament.

2. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 of the Scheme the definition of "railex service" shall be deleted.

Same day packets

3.—(1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme the words "the word "Speedpost" or other "shall be deleted.

(2) In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme the words "Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing no same day packet will be accepted for transmission on a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday." shall be deleted.

Railex service

4. Paragraph 29 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

Redirection by the public

5. In sub-paragraph (3)(b) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the figure "10p" shall read "12p".

Compulsory registration

6. In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 40 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the figure "10p" shall read "12p".

Recorded delivery service

7. In sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) of paragraph 43 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the figure "10p" shall read "12p".

Customs regulations, prepayment of duty and clearance of incoming packets

8. In sub-paragraphs (3)(a) and (3)(b) of paragraph 70 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the figure "45p" shall read "55p".

Incoming packets in bond

- 9. The following amendments are made to paragraph 71 of the Scheme as subsequently amended:
 - (1) In sub-paragraph (2)(ii) the table of fees shall be amended to read as follows:

(2) In sub-paragraph (5)(a) the figure "£1.50" shall read "£1.70" and the table of fees shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:

- "(i) Where there are not more than 5 parcels: £1.40 for each parcel.
- (ii) Where there are more than 5 parcels but not more than 30: £1.40 for each of the first 5 parcels and then 80p for each additional parcel.
- (iii) Where there are more than 30 parcels but not more than 200: for the first 30 parcels the fee for each as in (ii) and then 50p for each additional parcel.
- (iv) Where there are more than 200 parcels but not more than 300: 50p for each parcel.
- (v) Where there are more than 300 parcels: 45p for each parcel."

Letter and parcel rates

10. The following amendments are made to Schedule 1 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

- (1) Items (a)(i) and (a)(ii) of column 2 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:
- "(a) (i) For transmission as a first class letter 12p (ii) For transmission as a second class letter 10p"

(2) Items (b)(i) and (b)(ii) of column 2 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:

"(b) (i) For transmission as a first class letter
