POST OFFICE SCHEME P1/1982

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this note has been made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1979. The Scheme, which will come into operation on 1st February 1982, provides for postage rates and fees generally to be increased, extends the scope of the registered newspaper service to publications printed and published in any member state of the European Economic Community, and introduces provisions for earlier delivery of business reply and freepost packets.

THE POST OFFICE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 9) SCHEME 1982

Made 23rd December 1981

Coming into operation 1st February 1982

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and citation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st February 1982 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1982.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1979 (Post Office Scheme P1/1979) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1979 (Post Office Scheme P5/1979), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1980 (Post Office Scheme P1/1980), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1980 (Post Office Scheme P6/1980), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1981 (Post Office Scheme P1/1981), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1981 (Post Office Scheme P5/1981), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1981 (Post Office Scheme P11/1981), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1981 (Post Office Scheme P12/1981) and the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1981 (Post Office Scheme P15/1981).

Registration of newspapers

2. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme the words "two pounds" shall be deleted and the figure "£5" inserted in their place.

3. In sub-paragraph (6)(c) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme the words "the Republic of Ireland;" shall be deleted and the words "any State which is a member of the European Economic Community;" inserted in their place.

Royal Mail Special Delivery service

4. In sub-paragraph (6) of paragraph 26 of the Scheme the figure "£1.25" shall read "£1.50".

Business reply packets and postage forward parcels

5. In sub-paragraph (8) of paragraph 30 of the Scheme the figure "£15" shall be deleted and the words and figures "£20 in respect of a Business Reply Licence, and £22 in respect of a Postage Forward Parcel Licence," inserted in its place.

6. In sub-paragraph (9) of paragraph 30 of the Scheme the word and figure "of £15" shall be deleted.

7. The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted after sub-paragraph (10) of paragraph 30 of the Scheme:

"(11) If the Post Office at the request of the licensee delivers business reply packets to an address of the licensee by the first delivery of any day on which the Post Office ordinarily makes more than one delivery of postal packets to that address, the licensee shall pay such charge as the Post Office may from time to time determine in respect of each business reply packet delivered by such first delivery, in addition to the postage and fees otherwise payable."

Freepost licences

8. In sub-paragraph (9) of paragraph 31 of the Scheme the figure "£15" shall read "£20".

9. In sub-paragraphs (10)(a) and (11) of paragraph 31 of the Scheme the word and figure "of £15" shall be deleted.

10. The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted after sub-paragraph (13) of paragraph 31 of the Scheme:

"(14) If the Post Office at the request of the licensee delivers freepost packets to an address of the licensee by the first delivery of any day on which the Post Office ordinarily makes more than one delivery of postal packets to that address, the licensee shall pay such charge as the Post Office may from time to time determine in respect of each freepost packet delivered by such first delivery, in addition to the postage and fees otherwise payable."

Compensation for certain other postal packets

11. In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 47 of the Scheme the figure "£15" shall read "£16.50".

Fees and conditions

12. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 48 of the Scheme the figure "60p" shall read "65p".

13. In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 48 of the Scheme the figure "£250" shall read "£300".

14. In sub-paragraph (6) of paragraph 48 of the Scheme the figure "60p" shall read "65p".

Datapost service

15. In sub-paragraph (7) of paragraph 75 of the Scheme the figures "43, 47," shall read "42, 43,".

Letter and parcel rates

16. The following amendments are made to Schedule 1 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

(1) Items (a)(i) and (a)(ii) of column 2 of item 1 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:

"(a)(i) for transmission as a first class letter	15½p
(ii) for transmission as a second class letter	12½p

- (2) Items (b)(i) and (b)(ii) of column 2 of item 1 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:

“The appropriate rate in paragraph (a) minus 20p”.

- (6) The following item shall be inserted after item 4(b):

“(c) Where the Post Office allows transmission of a parcel which exceeds the size or weight limits shown in paragraph (a): such rate as the Post Office may fix, having regard to the size and weight.”

- (7) In column 2 of item 5 the figure “½p” shall be deleted and the words “such additional sum as the Post Office may fix” inserted in its place.
- (8) In column 2 of item 6, “7½p” shall read “8p”.
- (9) In column 2 of item 7 the figure “½p” shall be deleted and the words “such additional sum as the Post Office may fix” inserted in its place.

Postal facilities

17. The following amendments are made to Schedule 3 to the Scheme as subsequently amended:

- (1) In item 1, “1p” shall read “No fee”.
- (2) In item 2(b)(i), “1p per parcel” shall read “No fee”.
- (3) In item 2(b)(ii), “10p” shall read “No fee”.
- (4) In item 3, “6½p” shall read “10p”.
- (5) In items 4 and 5, “20p” shall read “22½p” and “40p” shall read “45p”.
- (6) In item 7(1)(a), “£32.50” shall read “£40”.
- (7) In item 7(1)(b), “£20” shall read “£25”.
- (8) In item 8A(1)(a), “£25” shall read “£30”.
- (9) In item 8A(1)(b), “£50” shall read “£60”.
- (10) In item 8A(3), the words “double the amount” shall be deleted and the words “an amount equal to the fee” inserted in their place.
- (11) In item 8A(4), “£90” shall read “£100”.
- (12) In item 8A(5), “£25” shall read “£30” in both places where it occurs.
- (13) In item 8A(6), “50p” shall read “75p”.
- (14) In items 9A(1)(a) and 9A(1)(d), “£25” shall read “£30”.
- (15) In item 9A(1)(b), “£50” shall read “£60”.
- (16) In item 9A(1)(c), “10A” shall read “8A”.
- (17) In item 9A(2), “£25” shall in each instance read “£30”.
- (18) In item 9A(3), “10A(4)” shall read “8A(4)” in both places where it occurs.
- (19) In item 10A(1), “£1.75” shall read “£2”.
- (20) In item 10A(2), “£4.25” shall read “£5”.

- (21) In item 10A(3), " £10.50 " shall read " £12 ".
- (22) In item 10A(4), " £21 " shall read " £35 ".
- (23) In item 10B, " £1.50 " shall read " £1.75 ".
- (24) In item 11, " 12 " shall read " 10 " and " £90 " shall read " £100 ".
- (25) In item 12(1), " £25 " shall read " £30 ".
- (26) In items 12(2)(i) and 12(2)(ii), " £5 " shall read " £5.50 ".
- (27) In item 13, " 10p " shall read " 15p " and " 14 " shall read " 12 ".
- (28) In item 14, " £8 " shall read " £10 ".
- (29) In item 15, " £20 " shall read " £25 ".
- (30) In item 16A(ii), " 10A(1)(a) " shall read " 8A(1)(a) ".
- (31) In item 16B, " 10 " shall read " 8 " in both places where it occurs.
- (32) In items 17A(a) and 17A(b), " £32.50 " shall read " £40 ".
- (33) In item 17B, after the words " Such fee " and before the words " as the Post Office may fix, ", there shall be inserted the following: " not exceeding £1.25 ".
- (34) In items 18(1)(b)(i) and 18(1)(b)(ii), " £3.75 " shall read " £4.50 ".

Express delivery services

18. In column 2 of item 3 of Schedule 4 to the Scheme as subsequently amended, " £1.25 " shall read " £1.50 ".

Registered postal packets

19. In Part I of Schedule 5 to the Scheme as subsequently amended, the words and figures under the headings " Column 1 " and " Column 2 " shall be deleted and the following inserted in their place:

21. In column 1 of Part I of Schedule 7 to the Scheme as subsequently amended, " 15p " shall read " 18p ".

Compensation for certain other postal packets

22. Paragraph 1 of Part I of Schedule 8 to the Scheme shall be deleted and the following inserted in its place:

" 1. On the posting of the packet a certificate of posting shall be obtained."

ARUN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Arun District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Arun District Council in exercise of their powers under sections 31 (1), (2) and (4), 52, and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of West Sussex in accordance with section 28A (2) of the Act of 1967 and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84 C (1) of the Act of 1967 propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to amend The Arun District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Bognor Regis) Order 1981 and The Arun District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Littlehampton) Order 1981 as amended by The Arun District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1982 so that:

- (1) Fitzleet parking place at Bognor Regis will be introduced as a Central Short Term car park the charges proposed to be made for its use and the classes of vehicle for which it will be available are specified in the Schedule.
- (2) The use of period season tickets will be extended, the holder will be entitled to park in any of the Littlehampton Central or Bognor Regis Central car parks, except Fitzleet, Bognor Regis.
