The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme.

*Comment and citation***1 This Scheme**

- (a) shall come into operation on 2nd September 1985,
- (b) may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No 16) Scheme 1985,
- (c) shall be read as one with the Post Office (Postal Order) Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P5/1971) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), the Post Office (Postal Order) (Amendment (No 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P4/1973) and the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No 15) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme P5/1984).

*Issue and amounts of postal orders***2 For sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 4 of the Scheme there shall be substituted the following**

"(1) Postal Orders may be issued for the following sums

- (a) any multiple of 5 pence up to and including 50 pence,
- (b) the sum of 60 pence, 70 pence, 75 pence, 80 pence, 90 pence and one pound,
- (c) any sum greater than one pound as the Post Office may from time to time determine."

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS**BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL****Royal County of Berkshire (Windsor) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1985**

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 (1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to:

- (a) Prohibit waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice
- (b) Restrict waiting to 1 hour with return prohibited within 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice
- (c) Designate the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 as residents' parking places, where only residents may park between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. on any day
- (d) Designate the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this notice as parking places where permit holders may park between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. and restrict waiting to one hour with return prohibited within two hours for all other traffic during this period.
- (e) Designate the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this notice as parking places where permit holders may park between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. and restrict waiting to two hours with return prohibited within 4 hours for all other traffic during this period
- (f) Make residents in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 6 eligible for the issue of parking permits
- (g) Revoke parts of the following Orders insofar as they are affected by this proposal

(1) The Royal Borough of Windsor (Various Streets) (Prohibitions and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1966 Schedule 1

(2) The Royal Borough of New Windsor (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971 Schedule 1

(3) The Royal Borough of New Windsor (Various Roads) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971

(4) The Royal Borough of New Windsor (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1974

(5) The Royal County of Berkshire (Kings Road, Windsor) (Residents Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

(6) The Royal Borough of New Windsor (Brook Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1960

Permits will be issued on the basis of two per household at a cost of £5 per permit per annum. Special provisions have been made for old age pensioners and registered disabled persons
