POST OFFICE SCHEME 1/1988

NOTE. The Scheme which follows this note has been made under section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and amends the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1979. The Scheme, which will come into operation on 17th June, 1988, provides for alterations to the general conditions concerning items prohibited from being sent in the Inland Post.

(This note is not part of the Scheme).

THE POST OFFICE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 20) SCHEME 1988

Made - - - - - 10th June 1988
Coming into operation - - - - - 17th June 1988

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and Citation

1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 17th June 1988 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 20) Scheme 1988.

2. Prohibitions in paragraph 8(2)(a)(i), after the words "any living creature" there shall be inserted the following:

"or blood, or any blood product, or serum, or urine, or semen, or any pathological specimen, or any vaccine, or asbestos, or any corrosive, flammable or oxidising material, or any organic peroxide, or matches, or any radioactive material, or any gas compressed, liquified or dissolved under pressure, or any paint, varnish or enamel, or any poison, or dry ice,".

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Bedfordshire (Park Street, Ampt Hill) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Bedfordshire ("the Council") propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles at all times on lengths of Park Street, Ampt Hill.

The lengths of road concerned are the south side of Park Street extending from its junction with Bedford Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 23 metres and the north side of Park Street from its junction with Bedford Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 36 metres.
