The Scheme, which comes into effect on 5th April 1993, revises the charges applicable to parcels to all countries and certain other fees. The Express and Delivery Free of Charges facilities are ceased. Services to the Channel Islands, which now becomes an International destination, are now provided under this Scheme.

THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 15) SCHEME 1993

Made11th March 1993
Coming into operation.....6th April 1993

The Post office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby make the following Scheme:

Commencement and citation

1. (i) This Scheme shall come into operation on 5th April 1993 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Parcel Amendment (No. 15) Scheme 1993.

(ii) Paragraph 20 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

Cash on delivery parcels

16. (i) In subparagraph (1) of paragraph 21 of the scheme "and shall be . . . whole new pence" shall read "and shall be a sum of money in sterling".

(ii) In subparagraph (2) (b) of paragraph 21 of the scheme "by means . . . a pencil" shall read "in ink".

(iii) Subparagraph (2) (c) of paragraph 21 of the scheme shall be deleted and the following substituted "The sender shall mark the PFU5 Despatch Pack with the amount of the trade charge according to the instructions provided."

(iv) In subparagraph (2) (d) of paragraph 21 of the scheme "by means . . . a pencil" shall read "in ink" and "money order form" shall read "card (R4)".

(v) In subparagraph (2) (g) of paragraph 21 of the scheme "by means . . . money order or" shall be deleted.

(vi) In subparagraph (3) (a) of paragraph 21 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, "£1.30" shall read "£3.00".

(vii) Subparagraphs (4), (5), (6) and (7) of paragraph 21 of the scheme shall be deleted.

Delivery free of charges

17. (i) The heading "Delivery Free of Charges" shall be deleted from the scheme.

(ii) Paragraph 22 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

Insured parcels and uninsured parcels containing valuables

18. (i) The heading "Insured parcels and uninsured parcels containing valuables" shall read "Delivery of incoming insured parcels".

(ii) Subparagraph (2) of paragraph 23 of the scheme shall be deleted.

Compensation

19. (i) In paragraph 24 of the scheme "(1)" shall be inserted immediately after "24".

(ii) In subparagraph (12) of paragraph 24 of the scheme "an insured . . . and packing" shall read "a parcel".

(iii) A subparagraph (14) of paragraph 24 shall be added as follows:

"(24) No compensation shall be paid in respect of:

(a) Standard and Economy Service items sent to the Philippines

(b) Standard Service items sent to Nigeria or Romania

(c) Standard and/or Economy Service items sent to any country which the Post Office has determined in its discretion shall be excluded from the provisions of paragraph 24 (1)".

The works will consist of the importation of approximately 8,000 cubic metres of graded beach material, placing it on the foreshore and grading it to the required profile.

The estimated cost of the works, inclusive of salaries of technical staff and other costs, is £142,500.
