The Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1988
Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Boróugh of. Barnet on 31st August 1988, made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so as to continue in force indefinitely the Provisions of the Barnet (Prescribed $\mathbb{R o u t e}$ ) (No. 1) experimental Traffic Order 1987.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements there of or of any relevant regifations
