## **ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS**

## LIE BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### The Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 31st August 1988, made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so as to continue in force indefinitely the Provisions of the Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No. 1) experimental Traffic Order 1987.

The general effect of the Order will be to impose one-way working for vehicular traffic in Brent View Road so that vehicles in Brent View Road must travel in a direction from West Hendon Broadway towards Park Road.

The one-way workings referred to above will not apply in relation to anything done:

- (a) With the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by a traffic sign placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.
- A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 9th September 1988 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at:

- Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements there of or of any relevant regulations
