THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST
AMENDMENT (No. 8) SCHEME 1988

Made 22nd August 1988.
Coming into operation 5th September 1988.

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION

1. (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 5th September 1988 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1988.

(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P2/1982) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P6/1982), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1983 (Post Office Scheme P4/1983), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 3/1984), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 4/1985), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 2/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 5/1986), and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 2/1987).

Air mail packets

2. (1) In sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 9 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "26p" shall be deleted and "27p" inserted in its place.

(2) In sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 9 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "13p" shall be deleted and "14p" inserted in its place.

Bulk posting in mail bags

3. In sub-paragraph (1)(a) of paragraph 10 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£1.25" shall be deleted and "£1.35" inserted in its place.

Accelerated treatment and express delivery

4. In sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 29 of the Scheme, the amount "£1.50" shall be deleted and "£1.65" inserted in its place.

Registration

5. In sub-paragraph (2)(c) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£1.20" shall be deleted and "£1.40" inserted in its place.

Compensation for certain other postal packets

6. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 37 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£18" should be deleted and "£20" inserted in its place.

Advice of delivery, enquiries and claims for compensation

7. (1) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 38 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "21p" shall be deleted and "25p" inserted in its place.

(2) Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 38 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following inserted in its place:

"The sender of an outgoing registered postal packet, on making a request within one year after the date of posting, may cause an enquiry to be made into the suspected loss or non-delivery of the packet."

(3) Sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 38 of the Scheme shall be deleted.

International Reply Coupons

8. In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 39 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "55p" shall be deleted and "60p" inserted in its place.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 31st August 1988, made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so as to continue in force indefinitely the Provisions of the Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No. 1) experimental Traffic Order 1987.

The general effect of the Order will be to impose one-way working for vehicular traffic in Brent View Road so that vehicles in Brent View Road must travel in a direction from West Hendon Broadway towards Park Road.

The one-way workings referred to above will not apply in relation to anything done:

(a) With the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

(b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by a traffic sign placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 9th September 1988 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements there of or of any relevant regulations
