Commencement and citation

- 1. This Scheme shall come into operation on 4 July 2002 and may be cited as the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 4) Scheme 2002.
- 2. This Scheme shall be read as one with the Successor Postal Services Company Inland Parcel Post Scheme 2001^(b) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), as amended by the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 1) Scheme 2001^(c), the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Posts (Amendment No 2) Scheme 2001^(d) and the Consignia plc Inland Parcel Post (Amendment No 3) Scheme 2002^(e).
- 3. A reference in this Scheme to the Successor Postal Services Company shall be read as a reference to Consignia plc.

The Scheme, which comes into operation on 4th July 2002 revises certain postage rates and fees and amends the definition of printed material that may be enclosed in printed packets weighing more than two kilogrammes.
