

**British Somaliland Protectorate.**

**THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT  
(No. 8) WARRANT, 1904. DATED FEBRUARY 18, 1904.**

1904. No. 202.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 8) Warrant 1904."

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1902,\* and all Warrants amending the same.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

3. On every outgoing parcel addressed to the British Somaliland Protectorate there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage following, that is to say:—

Rates to British Somaliland.

—	By Sea direct.	Via France or via France and Italy.
If not exceeding three pounds in weight ...	s. d. 1 0	s. d. 2 0
If exceeding three pounds and not exceeding seven pounds in weight ... ..	2 0	3 0
If exceeding seven pounds and not exceeding eleven pounds in weight ... ..	3 0	4 0

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight of which shall exceed eleven pounds or the dimensions of which shall exceed three feet six inches in length or six feet in length and girth combined.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 22nd day of February, 1904.
