We, the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this

Warrant, made on the representation of Her Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same), order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 1. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Post Warrant, 1898,\* and all Warrants amending the same.

Rates of postage on letters to and from Malta. 2, The Foreign and Colonial Post Warrant, 1898, shall apply to letters transmitted to and from Malta as if Malta were specified in the Second Schedule to the said Warrant.

Short title.

3. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Post (Amendment No. 2) Warrant, 1899."

Commencement. 4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1899.
